Two years after killing, Downey family still seeking justice

a homicide victim is asking for help to bring their loved one's suspected killer into custody, now two years after their loved one's murder.

28-year-old Andrew Martin Rosales was shot and killed in the 7000 block of Stewart and Gray Road after an argument turned




