

Paramount kindergartener stars with John Cena in Make-A-Wish campaign

PARAMOUNT – Paramount Unified’s Keppel Elementary students rallied behind three classmates who are battling cancer by raising \$3,062 for the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society’s Pennies for Patients research program.

“Through the fundraiser, we wanted students to see that they can make a difference right now where they are, and that they do not have to wait until they are older to make a positive impact on people,” Keppel Principal Darrenn Platt said.

“It is rewarding for the students to know that the money raised is going to help kids like them, and it teaches our students to be leaders and to use their voices.”

During the month of March, a challenge was held with classrooms

competing to see who could raise the most money. Water bottles were placed outside of each classroom, with classes gaining points for pennies added and losing points for silver change and dollars.

“Paramount Unified is committed to instilling positive values in our students with charitable opportunities that will resonate with them,” Paramount Unified Superintendent Dr. Ruth Pérez said. “We want to guide our students as they become citizens who focus on the wellbeing of others, and through Pennies for Patients they are able to give back and make a huge difference.”

Kindergartener Emelyne Ramirez, one of the Keppel students who is a cancer survivor and in her

second year of remission, made her national debut as a princess in the Make-A-Wish Foundation’s promotional campaign video.

The commercial, which aired in March, shows Ramirez in a pink dress and tiara as she stars alongside WWE wrestler and actor John Cena.

“It was a really beautiful experience for Emelyne and her favorite part was being a princess,” her mother, Laura Ramirez, said. “We went through a really rough time and when we finished with the treatments there was this fear that it would come back, but the Make-A-Wish Foundation made us feel happy and gave us hope to see all the children who made it past their illnesses.”

Emelyne’s kindergarten class

was one of the top donators, and as a reward earned a classroom pizza party.

Pennies for Patients is part of the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society’s Student Series, a three-week fundraiser designed to introduce students to service learning with proceeds going to the research and treatment of blood cancers.

“To support their classmates and raise money for a commendable cause demonstrates the thoughtfulness and empathy that we nurture in our students and future leaders,” Board of Education President Vivian Hansen said. “I am so proud of the Keppel Elementary students for taking the time to participate in a wonderful community service opportunity.”

Former resident Mary Champlin dies at 100

NORWALK – Mary Stuart Champlin was born Jan. 6, 1918 in New Baltimore, Michigan. She was the fourth child of William and Harriet Stuart.

The Stuart family moved to Long Beach in 1922 due to her mother’s ill health. She attended local schools and graduated from Excelsior High School in Norwalk.

That summer she came to visit her cousin, Barbara LaForge for a few weeks. During her visit she met her future husband, Ivan Champlin, at the La Granada Ballroom.

She attended Bakersfield College and soon married Ivan in February

1937. The young couple moved to the Fruitvale area where they lived until her 92nd year. From this union they raised two children, Ivan R. Champlin and JoAnn Poteet.

Mary was active in the Fruitvale community PTA and later worked as a cafeteria helper. When that job ended she was hired as a classroom aide until her retirement at age 62.

After suffering a stroke, she moved to Santa Maria to live with her daughter, JoAnn Poteet. She celebrated her 100th birthday in January surrounded by friends and family.

She passed away peacefully on March 25.

Kaiser workers protest Downey City Council meeting

► Healthcare workers are protesting Kaiser Permanente's intention to outsource 61 warehouse jobs.

Council members are reluctant to involve themselves in a private labor dispute.

DOWNEY — Several Kaiser Permanente employees protested Tuesday's City Council meeting, hoping to persuade council members to step in and help save several warehouse jobs that are on the chopping block.

Kaiser is set to outsource around 61 warehouse jobs from its Downey location. The possible action was first brought to public attention around two months ago

when workers picketed in front of the hospital.

Hospital workers say that the only thing that has changed since the protest is that the company has served official notice of the planned outsourcing.

"The company did serve official 60-day notice to the [United Healthcare Workers West] Union - and thus the workers - that they're going to be closing that warehouse on May 23rd," said Gabriel Montoya, an emergency room assistant at Kaiser and union member.

"Kaiser has been doing outsourcing at multiple locations, and of course as a union, as workers we're going to fight back against that. The reality is Kaiser can afford to pay their workers a living wage; they can afford to pay people who

work in Downey a middle-class wage with good benefits. If they want to keep to what they say to people as far as commitment to the community, then part of that is making sure that you keep good paying jobs in that community."

Before the meeting, Montoya said that this was a reflection of both Kaiser's and the City Council's commitment to produce good jobs in the community. He hoped that council would be willing to have a conversation with the healthcare workers and leaders at Kaiser.

"If you look across the state, Kaiser does have healthcare contracts with multiple municipalities," said Montoya. "Do those municipalities want to partner with people who are willing to outsource jobs to save

a buck? We also want to make sure that Downey City Council has a full understanding of how that affects their economy. As a city councilman, you want to be able to say that you fought for good jobs in your community...if they're already here, keep them there.

No city council member would want to tout 'I sat back while good jobs left my city,' because then there's an accountability issue that you have with the citizens. By the way, many of those citizens work at Kaiser and live in the city."

Kaiser released a statement, saying:

"We have been working for nearly a year with the unions representing our employees who work within our pharmacy warehouses, on how to address the many regulatory, technological and efficiency challenges we face now and in the future. After careful deliberations and extensive discussions with our unions,

including SEIU-UHW (17 all-day sessions over the past year), Kaiser Permanente reached the conclusion that an external pharmacy storage and distribution network is the best option for meeting the current and future needs of our members.

"As we determine the potential impact to employees, plans will be finalized and shared directly with them. We would add that it is no coincidence that SEIU-UHW's planned activity is occurring the week before bargaining is to begin with our union partners to fully address the effects of this decision.

"Kaiser Permanente is one of the largest private employers in California with more than 149,000 employees and 16,000 physicians in the state. Since 2015, we have added more than 13,000 jobs in California and continue to add jobs with more than 12,000 open staff positions and hundreds of physician positions. In the city of Downey alone, we employ nearly

6,000 people and currently have more than 400 jobs open.

"We never take decisions that affect our employees lightly, but it is important to recognize that the Downey pharmacy warehouse represents roughly 1 percent of our employee population in that city.

"We are proud of the kinds of support we offer our employees who might be affected by job changes. Our goal is to take all reasonable steps to redeploy the affected employees within Kaiser Permanente.

"If retention is not feasible given the circumstances, we provide tools and assistance, including up to one year of salary and benefits equal to the affected employees' then-current compensation, to support the affected employees and help them gain other employment opportunities.

"We can't say exactly what will happen in this case, because we have not completed discussions with union leadership, but we can tell you that in past cases we have demonstrated our ability to successfully redeploy the vast majority of affected employees."


Most of the healthcare workers and union members in attendance spoke at Tuesday night's meeting, each urging the council to intervene.

Unfortunately for them, however, it doesn't seem as though they will be getting much help from City Council.

When approached after the meeting, Councilman Fernando Vasquez said the city wouldn't involved itself in the dispute.

"It's a private matter," said Vasquez. "We're not privy to both sides of the negotiation. We obviously support anything that can increase jobs or create jobs in our city, but at the end of the day it's a private personnel matter that we hope both parties can work out."

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
