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Penny brothers retire Norwalk High School #22 jerseys

■ No other football player will ever wear #22 at Norwalk High School.

NORWALK - NFL football players and Norwalk High School alumni Elijahha ('11) and Rashaad ('14) Penny returned to their alma mater and retired their number 22 jerseys on Tuesday.

The brothers also received a \$500 donation toward their 2 Cents Family Foundation.

Elijahha Penny is the fullback for the New York Giants, and his younger brother Rashaad Penny was the running back for the Seattle Seahawks but is currently a free agent.

Despite the rain and the 52-degree weather, the Pennys' former teachers, classmates and coaches came out to support the two former NHS football players.

Coach Dean Gray has an extensive history with the Penny family, after coaching their older brother, Robert Penny.

"I'm so honored to say I coached Robert and watched Elijahha and Rashaad and have them in my class," said Gray. "The Penny family has done so much for the city of Norwalk and for the school. Congratulations on the retirement of 22."

Coach Jesse Cenicerros noted that Tuesday was used to mark the occasion because the Pennys' jersey number 22 and the date Feb. 22, 2022, lined up 2/22/22.

"How did everything align itself for today? To honor Elijahha and Rashaad who wore the number 22 so well," said Cenicerros. "I met Elijahha when he was a sophomore. He was big, but always had a smile on his face. That was my introduction to the Penny family."

Skills USA teams partnered together to donate \$500 to the Penny family foundation, 2 Cents Family Foundation. The family charity is dedicated to getting young people active with the two brothers hosting free football camps for boys and girls.

As the brothers retired their #22 jerseys, they thanked their former teachers and encouraged NHS students to continue pursuing their careers.

"My message to you kids is that you need to make school a priority," said Elijahha Penny. "So that you can go to the school you dream of right out of high school."

The Giants fullback was unable to go straight to a four-year university out of high school, after failing to meet his A-G requirements.

"My family, coaches, staff and former players all pushed

me to keep doing what I do, and I appreciate it," said the NHS 2011 alumnus

Rashaad Penny also thanked his former teachers and everyone who inspired him through his career.

"This city really changed my family life and my life," said Rashaad Penny. "Every time I come back I feel like I have family here. It means the world to me."

The NFL free agent thanked his former coach, Eddie Moreno.

"If Eddie hadn't found my older brother, I don't know where I'd be right now," said the NHS 2014 alumnus. "I really appreciate you."

Homeless count begins across LA County

■ Volunteers are spreading across the county as the homeless population continues to grow year after year.

NORWALK - Following a one-month postponement due to the surge in COVID-19 cases in Los Angeles County, the 2022 Greater Los Angeles Point-in-Time Homeless Count began Tuesday evening -- with volunteers spreading out to get an accurate count of the number of unhoused people in the area.

The count took place over three nights beginning Tuesday, starting in the San Gabriel and San Fernando valleys.

On Wednesday, the count was in West Los Angeles, Southeast Los Angeles and the South Bay area. On Thursday, counters fanned out in the Antelope Valley, Metro Los Angeles and South Los Angeles.

The effort is essential to understanding how large the region's homelessness crisis has become. It must be conducted by Continuum of Care providers to receive federal funding through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

"This is a moral crisis of a

magnitude that governments, the private sector, philanthropy can't end in isolation. It's going to take all of us and you being a participant and volunteering in the count is a perfect example of ways in which you can step up and help us by identifying who needs care and the kind of care they need," Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors Chair Holly Mitchell said Tuesday.

The count's organizers are still seeking more than 1,000 additional volunteers to help the effort through Thursday, according to LAHSA Executive Director Heidi Marston. People can sign up to volunteer at theycountwillyou.org.

This year's count will be the county's first since 2020, as last year's was canceled when LAHSA determined it was not safe to gather 8,000 volunteers amid stay-at-home orders and curfews due to COVID-19. The county received an exemption from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and was not required to conduct a 2021 count.

Due to the ongoing pandemic, volunteers will conduct the count by driving around the area, instead of some volunteers fanning out on foot.

"I am sure it'll feel a bit awkward to participate in the count from your car without the ability to directly offer

help, but please know that your contribution this count gives us critical data that every year informs policymakers at every level of government around policy decisions, resulting in direct services and homes for our unhoused," Mitchell said.

Other changes this year include moving deployment sites outdoors, moving volunteer training sessions online, encouraging volunteers to minimize cross-group interactions, requiring masks and encouraging volunteers to be vaccinated.

Volunteers will also use an app to collect and submit information electronically for the first time, instead of using clipboard and writing down their information physically.

This year's count was originally planned for Jan. 25-27, but the county's surge in COVID cases, fueled by the Omicron variant, forced a change in plans.

Mayor Eric Garcetti noted that the count, along with additional funding, will allow officials to track the progress of programs already funded.

"I can certainly see in encampments, where we've seen successful strategies of the city and county working together with our federal and state partners, where we had huge encampments



and are being able to see that sort of progress. But we know we can't get more money if we don't count people where they are," he said.

According to the 2020 count, Los Angeles County's homeless population increased by 12.7% over the previous year, while the city of Los Angeles' homeless population jumped by 14.2%.

In January 2019, Los Angeles County had 58,936 people experiencing homelessness, but by January 2020, the number rose to 66,433. The city of Los Angeles counted 36,165 in 2019 and 41,290 in 2020.

Results of the 2022 count are expected to be made public by LAHSA over the summer.

Norwalk reduces bus service

■ Struggling to hire bus operators, Norwalk temporarily scales back its regional bus service.

NORWALK - Norwalk is temporarily reducing bus service as it struggles to find and hire bus drivers.

The service reductions went into effect Sunday and impact four Norwalk Transit Service routes.

Officials said the service

cuts were necessary due to a nationwide shortage of bus operators due to the pandemic.

"NTS has strived to maintain its commitment of providing a full level of fixed-route transit service throughout the pandemic but the bus operator shortage has been a nationwide issue that has affected several public transportation agencies," said Mayor Rick Ramirez. "The service adjustments were approved to avoid further service disruptions."

The service reductions are

listed below:

Route 1 - There will be a temporary reduction in the number of assigned buses from six to five resulting in a reduction in frequency of service from buses arriving every 30 minutes to an estimated arrival time of every 37 minutes

Route 4 - The Route 4 express bus service is being temporarily discontinued. This route provides supplementary support to the regular Route 4 buses for commuter rail passengers to travel non-stop between

the Norwalk/Santa Fe Springs Metrolink commuter station and the Green Line Light Rail Station.

Route 7 - The Route 7 shuttle service is being temporarily discontinued. This route provides supplementary support to the regular Route 7 buses for passengers traveling non-stop between the El Monte Bus Station and Rio Hondo College.

Route 7 - Buses will arrive approximately every 60 minutes instead of the usual 45-50 minutes.

Also effective Sunday,

Norwalk Transit resumed front door boarding and fare collection, which was temporarily on pause since the start of the pandemic in 2020.

Norwalk Transit provides bus service on six routes within the southeast region of Los Angeles County including Artesia, Bellflower, Cerritos, El Monte, La Habra, La Mirada, Norwalk, Santa Fe Springs, South El Monte, Whittier and unincorporated Los Angeles County.



John Glenn's Mia Ramirez qualifies for CIF State

■ John Glenn, Norwalk broke grounds in qualifying for the CIF Masters.

HUNTINGTON BEACH – Marina High School in Huntington Beach was the site for the CIF-Southern Section Masters and John Glenn's Mia Ramirez (116 Lbs.) became the first in program history to qualify for the state championships with an eighth-place finish.

Rhain Arango (121 lbs.) was the other girls wrestler from Glenn who qualified for the Masters. She didn't make the final eight, which is the cutoff for state qualifiers.

In addition, Norwalk had four girls qualify for the CIF Masters for the first time in program history- Sabrina Sinohui (106), Zitali Sarmiento (131), Casey Otero (143) and Thalia Ariste (170).

On the boys side, which was held at Sonora, Norwalk had two wrestlers qualify for Masters - Sean Otero (145), 5th in Individuals and Jonah Fryer (160), 4th in Individuals.

Ramirez, who finished second in the CIF Individuals in the Northern Division, was 4-3 in her Masters appearance which included pins in each of her wins.

After her first-round win, she lost in the second round and fell into the consolation bracket and worked her way through the next three matches with pins.

Ramirez lost her last two matches by pins, the last one was a loss in the seventh-place match, but eighth place was the qualifier for state.

"Mia did punch a ticket to the state championships and she is the only wrestler from the City of Norwalk who qualified for state," said John Glenn coach Hector Ramirez, who is her father. "We are traveling there this weekend to Mechanics Bank Arena in Bakersfield."

Norwalk, on the other hand came close to having a wrestler advance to state. Sarmiento, who won her fifth-place match in Individuals, came within one minute and thirty seconds of qualifying for state.

She was 2-2 in Masters competition and was the only Lancer to qualify for the second day.

"She came to the program in the summer prior to her freshman year," Norwalk Girls Wrestling coach Bryan DeVries said. She impressed the coaching staff by her willingness to do a wrestling practice, then go to her Volleyball practice directly afterward.

"Mid-way through the year, we sat down and discussed how she had the potential to get to state given a little extra work. While she came up two wins shy of state, I have no doubt that she will put in the extra work needed to potentially become Norwalk's first girls state qualifier."

The three remaining Norwalk wrestlers left their mark at Masters.

"Ariste started coming to practices in December and always gave her all," DeVries added. "Her lack of practice time never deterred her from competing. She was a very pleasant surprise as a CIF placer due to her lack of time in the room and had a big win in Masters."

"She is tough as nails and always happy to compete. Thalia has a great attitude and will forever be connected with girls wrestling history."

Both Sinohui and Otero, are sophomores, went 0-2 at the Masters, but made an impression on the Lancers' staff.

"She (Sinohui) did what she has done all season," DeVries said. "She left it all on the mat - from the opening whistle to the final whistle."

"She didn't get the 'W', but she should be proud knowing that she gave it all. After two years off from the program, Sinohui came back to wrestling and made history - very loud history. She is, however, the loudest voice in the room and on the mat."

Otero, a sophomore, who along with her twin brother Sean Otero is in the second year of the program. She was introduced to wrestling last season and competed in one match and won it in the CIF Duals.

She has come a long way, as she was the highest placer with her third-place finish in individuals.

"These four young women each had their own paths and obstacles to overcome in order to get this far," DeVries said. "While they came up short of qualifying for state, they have blazed trails for current and future young ladies to know that doing well in wrestling and coming from Norwalk are possible. They no doubt will continue to inspire our team to strive for greatness."

Norwalk, which qualified 12 girls in the CIF Individuals, finished sixth overall out of 61 schools represented. They outscored previously ranked CIF teams such as El Toro, Santa Ana and Millikan.

The Lancers, who placed tenth out of 41 teams at Individuals, qualified a whopping 13 boys for CIF Individuals and had two advance to Masters.

Sean Otero, who finished 2-2 at Masters, and Fryer (0-2) both faced eventual Masters Champions.

"Sean has worked hard all season and had the rare opportunity to avenge almost every loss he had this year," said DeVries, who also assists boys coach Frank Soto, who is the head of Norwalk Wrestling. "Sean is only a sophomore and always improving and making adjustments to potential weaknesses in his own game. Sean continues to work hard and has a great attitude."

DeVries went on to say great things about the boys program also.


"The boys wrestled hard and with a lot of grit," he said. "They never let up and took down some top-ranked opponents. Very proud of the way these young men have continued to strive for excellence."

And finally there is the element that gives the teams' inspiration - "Little coach," Lylah DeVries - coach Bryan's daughter.

"She has voluntarily woken up at 4am to get ready for the day with me and make the team bus," DeVries said. "She has helped me to analyze matches and even coached a couple girls early on in tournaments when there were multiple wrestlers wrestling at once."


"She has made some positive relationships with these wrestlers and always gives the team great advice, Lylah wants the team to 'wrestle like your hair is on fire.'"

who is a volunteer coach that has helped me during these tournaments." DeVries added.

"The John Glenn girls wrestling had a very challenging season, coming off of one year of Covid," Hector Ramirez said. "The team pulled together and finished as four-time 605 League Champions."

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What is going on in Downey?

What is going on in Downey? It's a valid question that is being asked with greater frequency these days.

The City Council was thrown into further disarray this week when Councilman Sean Ashton announced his resignation – effective March 18 – citing a promotion at FedEx. Ashton's departure comes at a critical time for Downey.

After seven years in office, Ashton was Downey's most senior councilmember. For this reason his colleagues voted him mayor pro tem last December, hopeful he would be a calming influence on a city council that has grown increasingly divided over the future of the city.

That didn't happen. Instead, Ashton joined council members Catherine Alvarez and Mario Trujillo in successfully ousting city manager Gilbert Livas without explanation. Livas's preference was to serve Downey a few more years but instead he will retire July 1.

Alvarez herself is facing another recall effort after her opponents came 35 signatures short of triggering a special election. Now armed with a certified list of valid signatures, organizers are confident they can secure the three dozen additional signatures they need.

Meanwhile, Mayor Blanca Pacheco is a leading candidate in the race for the 64th Assembly District. If successful, Pacheco would resign her District 1 city council seat. Oh, and Councilmember Claudia Frometa is up for re-election in District 4.

There are a lot of moving parts to process, so to recap:

District 1 – Pacheco will resign if elected to the state Assembly.

District 2 – Ashton has resigned effective March 18..

District 3 – Alvarez faces a potential recall.

District 4 – Frometa is up for reelection this November.

We haven't even mentioned that Downey is currently without a mayor pro tem.

As it stands, District 5 councilman Mario Trujillo is the only stable representative on the city council. Elected in 2020, he has another two years left before he can seek reelection.

Ashton's resignation means the four remaining council members can appoint someone to finish the eight months left on his term. But whether they can agree on a qualified replacement remains a big question mark. Alvarez and Trujillo are liberal Democrats, while Pacheco and Frometa are moderates, and their political differences have become more pronounced in the past year.

Ashton's replacement will be a swing vote on the council and have an important voice in who Downey hires as its next city manager, a tall task for a rookie council member.

It cannot be overstated how important a stable city council is to a city. It affects the quality of employees a city is able to attract, from white collar workers at city hall to police officers and firefighters. It affects

quality of life in Downey, from our parks to our streets. It affects our fiscal health. It affects property values.

Ashton's resignation creates an opportunity for Downey to appoint a civic-minded resident who will cast votes and make decisions in the best interest of the entire community, and whose values align with the majority of the constituency. Above all, residents should demand a council member who is truthful and transparent about their goals for Downey.

As for Ashton's legacy, what can you say? He curiously left a teaching job to deliver packages for FedEx, and never leveraged his position of influence to affect great change in the city. He claimed ignorance when it was revealed the county was building transitional housing at Rancho Los Amigos (his district), and he was secretly criticized by city officials for missing meetings or leaving meetings early. He spinelessly aligned with protestors who used bullhorns outside council members' homes, frightening their families. Most egregiously, on his way out the door, he forced out a beloved and competent city manager without saying why.

Ashton leaves the city council with his legacy tarnished and our local government in disarray. The onus is now on our four council members to put their differences and egos aside and do what's best for the great city of Downey.

Why canceling the gas tax is a bad idea

In politics, there are proposals that are so sensible they are bound to become law. There are ideas so awful that they are quickly discarded and forgotten. Then there are the ones that have no chance of being enacted but keep coming back.

They are the zombies of public policy: not exactly alive, but never quite dead. A prime example is the gas tax holiday. Several Democratic senators have signed on to a bill to suspend the 18.4-cents-per gallon federal levy to reduce the cost of fuel and combat inflation.

Sen. Mark Kelly, D-Ariz., argues that lifting the gas tax would be "something that directly helps people right now when they need it." Senate Majority Leader Chuck Schumer says, "It's one of the many things that we're looking at in terms of reducing costs." The White House declines to rule it out.

No one likes paying taxes or feeling gouged at the pump, which explains the appeal to politicians. Democratic pollster Celinda Lake regards it as "a great populist issue because people are always mad at gas prices and gas taxes."

Democrats would do well to recall the example of Barack Obama. During his 2008 presidential campaign, he had to contend with two rivals, Democrat Hillary Clinton and Republican John McCain, who proposed the same thing. Obama had the backbone to deride it as "a gimmick that would save you (the cost of) half a tank of gas over the course of the entire summer so that everyone in Washington can pat themselves on the back and say they did something." He found an unlikely ally in George W.

Bush.

It's a lousy idea, for reasons that should be most obvious to Democrats. They united to help pass Joe Biden's \$1 trillion infrastructure bill, which will be financed partly with revenue from the federal gas tax. As the bipartisan Committee for a Responsible Federal Budget notes, a gas tax holiday would deprive the Highway Trust Fund, which pays for roads, bridges and mass transit, of \$20 billion a year.

If that weren't bad enough, the trust fund has been spending more than it takes in, putting it on schedule to go broke by 2027. Suspending the gas tax would move that date up by a year.

It would also contradict another core Democratic goal: reducing our reliance on fossil fuels. High gas prices, as it happens, are a good way to encourage conservation, enhance the appeal of electric vehicles and curb greenhouse gas emissions. Larry Summers, who was director of Obama's National Economic Council, said last summer, "There's no more important price to increase in the American economy than the price of carbon-based fuels."

Summers was rebuking Biden for urging oil-producing nations to boost output to lower prices — even though the more oil they produce and the world consumes, the faster the planet will heat up. "On the surface, it seems like an irony," Biden acknowledged. Actually, a better term would be "self-contradiction."

That wasn't Biden's only divergence from sensible methods of combating climate change. In November, he released 50 million barrels of oil from the Strategic Petroleum Reserve. The White House explanation:

"Oil supply has not kept up with demand as the global economy emerges from the pandemic." Never mind the obvious way to balance demand and supply: letting prices rise.

Contrast these efforts with what Biden said in canceling the Keystone pipeline from Canada: "The United States and the world face a climate crisis. That crisis must be met with action on a scale and at a speed commensurate with the need to avoid setting the world on a dangerous, potentially catastrophic, climate trajectory."


Not that Republicans are any more honest or consistent. As prices were rising in 1996, presidential nominee Bob Dole advocated not merely suspending but abolishing the federal gasoline tax. He and GOP House Speaker Newt Gingrich said it was "the least we can do for hard-working Americans whose pocketbooks are taking a major hit." McCain said similar things in 2008.

Both parties are prone to irresponsible pandering, and each has found occasions to target the gas tax for political exploitation. But it's never energized public support, most likely because most people don't see 18.4 cents per gallon as that big a deal.

The consolation is that each time the idea emerges, cooler and smarter heads make sure it goes nowhere. It will probably go nowhere this time. But only after we've had our intelligence insulted.

When the government outsources torture

After a jury in 2006 declined to impose the death penalty on Zacarias Moussaoui, who had just pleaded guilty to being the 20th 9/11 hijacker, the government announced that another person was the 20th. Yet, that person, Mohammed al-Qahtani, was ordered released from the U.S. Naval prison at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, last week.

Here is the backstory.

Moussaoui had been living in Minnesota and taking flying lessons when he was arrested in August 2001 for an immigration violation. When officials questioned him, the answers he gave aroused their suspicions about what he intended to do with a plane once he was qualified to fly.

The FBI conducted a criminal investigation, and shortly after 9/11, Moussaoui was indicted in Virginia for conspiracy to commit acts of terrorism on 9/11. The government sought the death penalty. Five years later, he pleaded guilty during his trial.

The court then conducted a penalty-phase trial before the same jury that had been hearing the case prior to the guilty plea. The jury declined to impose the death penalty with some jurors revealing their beliefs that

he had nothing to do with 9/11, but was a jihadi wanna-be. The judge sentenced him to life in prison without possibility of parole.

Stung by the jury's verdict on the death penalty, the government changed its characterization of Moussaoui as the 20th hijacker and declared that Mohammed al-Qahtani was the real 20th hijacker.

In August 2001, Qahtani had attempted to enter the United States at the Orlando International Airport where Mohamed Atta, one of the true hijackers, was waiting to greet him. Immigration officials rejected Qahtani's paperwork and sent him back to Dubai. U.S. forces arrested him in Pakistan in December 2001 and accused him of being Osama bin Ladin's bodyguard.

He was transferred to the military prison at Guantanamo Bay where he was tortured for two months in 2002 and 2003 by the military, pursuant to orders issued by Secretary of Defense Donald H. Rumsfeld. He told his torturers what he thought they wanted to hear. His torture was so persistent and horrific that Army medics were frequently called upon to prevent his death and to revive him from his frequent blackouts so that the torture could resume.

When detailed logs of his torture were leaked to the media, Susan J. Crawford, President George W. Bush's emissary overseeing tortures and prosecutions at Gitmo, acknowledged publicly that "we tortured (him)" and thus it would be impossible to try him.

Last week, the government decided to release Qahtani — whom it believes was the true 20th hijacker — to officials in Saudi Arabia. The stated reason for his release is his diminished mental capacity. The true reason is that he has become an embarrassment for the government.

Gitmo prosecutors, who had nothing to do with the torture, told the Bush Departments of Justice and Defense that no judge would permit a prosecution where the principal evidence against the accused was obtained from his torture. Successive teams of prosecutors told the Obama, Trump, and Biden DOJs and DODs the same. Only the present administration has acted upon this.

Qahtani's case is a lesson in the clash between human rights and unbridled government. If Rumsfeld had listened to government lawyers, he'd have known that the American civilian and military legal systems are based on the inalienability of certain rights and values, and among them are bodily integrity, the presumption of innocence and the rule of law.

The Supreme Court jurisprudence on bodily integrity prohibits the introduction of anything into or upon the body of any person against his will. This includes everything from face masks, to whips and chains, to

chemicals in the veins. The rule of law in America makes the intentional infliction of pain and severe discomfort by the government upon a prisoner a felony.

Neither Bush nor Rumsfeld had the legal authority to permit government agents to commit felonies, though we now know that they did.

But the big picture in Qahtani's case is the admirable role played by the Supreme Court in assuring that the Constitution means what it says and the cowardly role played by the government, which argued that the Constitution doesn't apply at its prison in Cuba.

In six Supreme Court cases involving the rights of Gitmo detainees, the Bush administration lost five. The sixth involved the location of the trial of an American detainee in the U.S.

But the jurisprudence that emerged from the five cases that the government lost clearly reflects the truism that the Constitution restrains the government wherever it goes, and its protections extend to all persons, not just Americans. The latter is so for two reasons — textualism and Natural Law.

The court held in these Gitmo cases that because the Constitution is the supreme law of the land and because the government is the creature of the Constitution, the creature cannot escape the restraints imposed upon it by its creator.

Moreover, the critical constitutional clauses reflecting the treatment of prisoners and defendants protect all "persons," not just Americans. Because all persons have natural rights rooted in our humanity, the government is bound to respect those rights. Were this not so, then nothing could prevent the government from doing as British monarchs did — remove prisoners to foreign lands, torture them there, and then bring them home for trial and execution.

Yet, that horrific Bush-inspired scenario actually happened. After Bush lost at the Supreme Court, the government outsourced its torture and now finds itself as a witness in cases against the foreign torturers whom it hired to torture its prisoners.


Even worse, the man jurors found was not the 20th hijacker is in prison for life, and the man the government says was the 20th hijacker will soon be free. This is what happens when the government breaks its own laws and violates the Constitution that we have hired it to uphold.



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DA backpedals on Hannah Tubbs sentencing

■ Hannah Tubbs was sentenced to two years in jail for the sexual assault of a child; George Gascón acknowledges it was lenient.

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County District Attorney George Gascón has issued a statement saying that one of his policies, which resulted in a transgender woman being ordered to serve two years in juvenile custody for sexually assaulting a 10-year-old girl in a restaurant bathroom "may not" be an adequate amount of time behind bars.

The county's top prosecutor, who backed away Friday from two of his most criticized directives including one that eliminated the option of trying juveniles as adults for serious crimes, said in the statement that he became aware after Hannah Tubbs' sentencing about "extremely troubling statements she made about her case, the resolution of it and the young girl that she harmed."

"While for most people, several years of jail time is adequate, it may not be for Ms. Tubbs," Gascón said of the 26-year-old defendant who was 17 at the time of the 2014 attack in Palmdale and whose case was handled in juvenile court as a result of a directive the district attorney issued the day he was sworn into office.

He noted that the defendant was arrested years after the crime "rather than the usual case, where a child is arrested close in time to their crime" and that Tubbs had "several charges in other counties after the juvenile offense but never received any services, which both her past behavior and that subsequent to her arrest demonstrates she clearly needs."

"If we knew about her disregard for the harm she caused, we would have handled this case differently. The complex issues and facts of her particular case were unusual and I should have treated them that way. This change in policy will allow us the space to do that moving forward," the district attorney said in his statement.

Gascón vowed in the December 2020 directive that the District Attorney's Office would "immediately END the practice of sending youths to the adult court system," but abruptly changed his position on that with a series of memos Friday to office staff including one in which he noted that "in exceptional circumstances, criminal jurisdiction may be appropriate for youth offenders" and that juveniles may be selectively transferred to the adult court system in the "most egregious cases that warrant a state prison commitment."

Supervisor Kathryn Barger called the outcome of Tubbs' case "unsatisfactory," saying in a Jan. 27 statement that the judge's hands were "tied ... due to the

fact that the DA's office failed to file a motion to transfer Tubbs to adult criminal court, which is where she rightly belongs."

In the statement issued Sunday night, Gascón said the office has "now implemented policies to create a different pathway for outlier cases while simultaneously creating protections to prevent these exceptions from becoming the rule."

The district attorney said he remains committed to the "core values of our policies," but has seen "a small number of cases that presented real challenges."

He said his office is making "minor adjustments" to its policies on juveniles, along with life-without-parole sentences for adults in certain murder cases, to "allow for exceptions in the most extraordinary of cases."

Gascón wrote in the statement Sunday that a prosecutor must put a request in writing when they want to "deviate from our core principles" and that the request will go to a committee "staffed by my most trusted advisors, who must evaluate the case and approve any requests to pursue an exception." He wrote that it will ensure "that only in the rarest of cases, where our system has failed, will we diverge from our principles."

The day he was sworn in, Gascón issued a directive mandating that special-circumstance allegations resulting in a sentence of life without parole shall not be filed and should be withdrawn from pending cases on which they had already been filed.

He was met with quick resistance, with the association representing more than 800 deputy district attorneys in Los Angeles County filing a lawsuit in December 2020 challenging some of Gascón's directives, including the requirement that prosecutors seek the dismissal of special-circumstance allegations in murder cases that were pending. The association contended that

the moves were "unlawful," and a number of judges in Los Angeles County refused to dismiss the allegations in cases that had been filed before Gascón took office.

A judge ruled mostly in favor of the Association of Deputy District Attorneys for Los Angeles County last February, but subsequently put the case on hold while Gascón appeals. A trial date is scheduled to be set for the case in April.


In one of the memos issued late Friday, Gascón noted that there "may be the rare occasion" in which special-circumstance allegations may be "necessary" that could result in a life prison term without parole in murder cases.

The policy changes come as the county's top prosecutor has come under fire from families of some crime victims, as well as Los Angeles County Sheriff Alex Villanueva, former Los Angeles Police Department Chief Charlie Beck and some prosecutors from his own office.

Addressing the policy changes, the district attorney said in his statement Sunday, "Like every responsible office, we learn as we go, take feedback from the community and make necessary adjustments based on our experiences and the complex nature of this work. That is the responsible way to govern. I have always been open to learning and growing in this work."

Gascón is facing a renewed recall effort that was announced in December. Recall supporters are working to collect 566,857 signatures from registered Los Angeles County voters for submission to the county registrar's office by July 6. A similar effort in 2021 failed to gather enough signatures to qualify.

Gascón has repeatedly defended his policies, saying his stances were well-known during his campaign and his election signified public support of his agenda.
