Whittier class helps students become citizens

■ A Whittier Adult School citizenship class found success with dedicated teachers.

WHITTIER – Whittier Union Adult School Citizenship class teachers are known for continually showering their students with care, support, devotion and celebrations as they navigate the steps of becoming a U.S. citizen, accomplishing what is a lifelong dream for many.

Teachers Jesus DeLaTorre and Katherine Herrick provide their students with application assistance and help refine their grammar, pronunciation, dictation and reading skills in preparation for their citizenship interview.

DeLaTorre and Herrick also provide instruction in American history and government to further prepare students for the citizenship test.

“At the end of my class, many of my students are more knowledgeable about the United States government than most current American citizens,” DeLaTorre said. “Many of my students juggle a job while caring for their children and families, and they want to earn their citizenship to have more stability.”

DeLaTorre first started teaching Whittier Union Adult School’s Citizenship class in 2016, after 40 years of teaching high school history, government and economics.

After retiring from his teaching job, a friend of his called and shared the Adult School needed a substitute teacher for a Citizenship class.

DeLaTorre discovered a new love and passion in substituting for the class, agreeing to stay on as the permanent Citizenship teacher shortly after.

“Once a teacher, always a teacher,” DeLaTorre said. “I get to teach people from all over the world and learn from them as much as they learn from me. It’s really my vocation.”

DeLaTorre and Herrick both ask former students to return and share their experience with the class after they have achieved citizenship to show how the class impacted their lives and encourage others to continue in the pursuit of their dream.

“Citizenship is such an important class at the Whittier Union Adult School,” Principal Margie Moriarty said.

“Mr. DeLaTorre and Ms. Herrick truly give their all to our students and show each and every one of them that anything is possible. We are proud of all of our students and are incredibly grateful for our amazing educators who make dreams a reality.”

Norwalk state of the city reviews development over the past year

■ City leaders recapped the past year and looked forward to new projects on the horizon.

NORWALK – Mayor Ana Valencia and Norwalk officials from the Chamber of Commerce and the city Sheriff’s Station reviewed the economic progress, safety improvements and development of Norwalk over the past year during the State of the City address on Oct. 20.

Chamber of Commerce

Caren Spilsbury, executive director of the Norwalk Chamber of Commerce, began by celebrating the chamber’s 100-year anniversary, then responded to state economic concerns and plans for business development in the community.

The executive director clarified the city is not in a recession as economists predicted last year. However, she explained the ongoing challenges with inflation continue to impact the city and create a trickle down effect on the economy.

“[Inflation] is down to about 3.7% through this last September compared to 9.1% a year and a half ago, but it still creates increased pricing for our residents and our consumers,” Spilsbury said. “Legislative decisions in Sacramento have taken away local control. Making decisions for our business owners that are not good for business also has a major effect on the economy.”

Spilsbury referred to AB 1228, which promises fast food workers a minimum wage of \$20 an hour starting April 2024. While employees would earn more money it would become difficult for small businesses to

compete and lose employees, she explained.

Norwalk has seen an increase in city business licenses. As of Jan. 2023 the city has 2,240 business licenses, an increase from the 2,163 business licenses in Jan. 2021, according to data from the Chamber of Commerce.

Sheriff’s Station

Richard Conti, captain of the Norwalk Sheriff’s Station, was promoted to overseeing the station during the summer in August. He expressed the station’s plan to collaborate with the public safety department.

Conti explained the efforts of the Norwalk Enforcement Team (NET), focused on crime suppression and community engagement. With an additional NET team, more officers would be available to handle calls from the community.

“A group of deputies we hand picked from our station are on this team,” Conti said. “We are going to give them training to adequately handle calls and that’s kept our crime down.”

The sheriff captain also elaborated on Public Safety Quadrants, where public safety officers are assigned to one of four quadrants in the city. Under the program, public safety would establish a personalized liaison between the community and the array of services at the sheriff’s department and the city.

“It’s all geared to find solutions to your problems,” Conti said. “These officers pledge to maintain open lines of communication again and this commitment fosters trust and strength between the community and the sheriff’s department.”

City Development

Mayor Valencia drew attention to significant projects, such as the Transit Village and the Norwalk Entertainment Center. The veteran housing project, neighborhood revitalization programs, and partnerships with major brands like Tesla were also highlighted.

Mayor Valencia unveiled projects including the transformation of the former California Youth Authority’s Correctional Center into the Norwalk Transit Village and the Norwalk Entertainment District, dubbed “The Walk.” These projects aim to attract businesses to the city by offering a mix of residential units, commercial spaces, and community gathering spots.

Downey mayor stays positive in State of the City speech

■ Mayor Claudia Frometa said the city is rebounding after three years of instability.

DOWNEY – Despite coming out of a tumultuous several months, Mayor Claudia M. Frometa announced that “the state of the city is strong” at her State of the City address on Thursday.

The event was put on by the Downey Chamber of Commerce at the Rio Hondo Event Center.

During her speech, Frometa enthused that the gaps in the city’s executive positions had been filled over the span of six months.

“We as a city, we’ve gone through a tremendous transition over the last several months,” said Frometa. “Again, I am pleased to tell you that in spite of the craziness, and in spite of

the uncertainty that we’ve lived over the past year, I am grateful to have a city manager and an executive team that are top-notch. They’re committed and dedicated to making our city, to turning back the tide, and making our city the strong city that it has always been.”

The city council’s overarching goals include fiscal responsibility, efficiency and adaptability, economic vibrancy, quality of life, safety and infrastructure, and public engagement.

Downey remains fiscally solvent, having passed its 11th consecutive balanced budget, consisting of a \$115 million general fund, \$118 million in appropriations, and \$9 million secured in grants.

“This year’s budget focuses on code enforcement, economic development, public works improvements, alleys, streets, and youth programming,” said Frometa.

Public safety continues to be the city’s biggest expenditure.



made the city’s intentions clear.

“We need housing,” said Frometa. “We are looking at housing developments in that particular area.”

While within city limits, the Rancho Los Amigos South Campus is County-owned land.

This year’s address also served as a birthday celebration of sorts, as Downey officially saw its 150th anniversary last Friday.

Los Angeles County Supervisor Janice Hahn, Senator Bob Archuleta, and Assemblymember Blanca Pacheco all were on hand to give statements to the city congratulating it on its success, longevity, and impact on the surrounding communities and the region.

“Downey, you are a beacon of light,” said Hahn. “People want to come here, they want to live here, they want to raise their families here, and that really speaks to the kind of city that you are.”

Although somewhat light on upcoming announcements, the Mayor did highlight the arrivals of the Chicken Coop and Shake Shack restaurants, anticipated to open in fall this year and in 2024, respectively.

A new Honda World car dealership is also impending, though an opening date has not yet been announced.

Paging Dr. Frischer...

We've been paying so much (quite warranted) attention to COVID that we sometimes forget that there are other viruses out there. Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) can be a serious and fatal illness for infants and for older adults.

RSV has long been considered a disease of the very young. We now know differently. It is common and highly contagious. Most people have mild, cold-like symptoms, and recover in a week or two, but infants and older adults can develop severe RSV and need hospitalization. Each year in the United States, over two million adults over age 65 become ill with RSV, some 177,000 are hospitalized, and about 14,000 die.

For several years now, researchers have been working on a vaccine to protect against this virus. Finally, this year, the FDA has approved Arexvy, from GlaxoSmithKline (GSK), as well as Abrysvo, from Pfizer, for those 60 and older. In addition, Abrysvo was given approval for use in pregnant women who are 32 to 36 weeks along.

Adults at increased risk for RSV should consider getting one of these RSV vaccines. This would include seniors; those with chronic lung disease, heart disease, kidney or liver disease or diabetes mellitus; those who reside in nursing homes or other long-term care facilities; pregnant women; and those who are moderately or severely immunocompromised.

These new RSV vaccines are safe and very effective. I urge you to speak with your doctor about whether it is appropriate for you.

Downey pediatrician offers Halloween safety advice

■ Simple tips can help keep children safe while trick-or-treating.

DOWNEY – Now that COVID-19 is less of a threat due to a majority of Californians being vaccinated, we're likely to see more ghosts, goblins and witches walking down neighborhood streets this Halloween, as trick-or-treating is expected to be a common sight in communities across Southern California.

For parents, keeping children safe during this festive holiday will be a main priority. Dr. Ann H. Kang, a pediatrician with Kaiser Permanente Downey, notes that although parents may feel more at ease having their children trick-or-treat this Halloween, there are important safety precautions they need to follow to avoid injury and illness.

She stressed the importance of children being up-to-date with their COVID-19 and flu vaccines. Additionally, she described seven scary health hazards parents should be familiar with to ensure families have a safe and happy Halloween this year.

Food allergies

When it comes to candy, peanuts and other foods, it's always important to read labels and avoid treats without labels. For parents whose children have severe allergic reactions to certain foods, it's important to carry an epinephrine auto-injector if prescribed.

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, food allergies account for 35% to 50% of all cases of severe, potentially life-threatening allergic reactions that can occur up to two hours of ingestion of food, such as peanuts.

Hand injury

Pumpkin carving is a cherished Halloween tradition that many families enjoy each year. However, pumpkin-related carving knife injuries can lead to nerve, tendon and artery injuries, – and they are preventable, notes Dr. Kang.

Understanding the risks and being careful can save you and your child a costly and traumatic visit to the emergency room. To avoid injuries, Dr. Kang encourages children to draw the pattern on the pumpkin, clean out the inside pulp and seeds with a spoon, but leave the knife work to mom and dad.

Fire hazards

What's Halloween without decorating your home with spooky decorations and, in many cases, lighted ornaments? However, Dr. Kang warns this can present some truly scary fire safety hazards. Lighting up your jack-o-lantern with glow sticks or electric candles is the safest option, she says.

Caution should always be exercised if using a real candle,

however. Some decorations are also very flammable, Dr. Kang notes. These include cornstalks, dried flowers, crepe paper and plastic banners. The top 5 causes of most Halloween fires include careless actions and electrical malfunctions, according to fire data tracked by FEMA.

Costumes

It's important for parents to ensure that their child's mask has large enough eye holes for them to see clearly, Dr. Kang says. Children should wear bright and reflective costumes, and parents should beware of any small parts on costumes on which a child could choke. Also, check the length of costumes to make sure they don't cause your child to trip.

Face paint/Costume contact lenses

Before you apply makeup near your child's eyes, beware since it could contain harmful chemicals, according to the American Academy of Ophthalmology. If makeup is applied, it should be applied in small amounts to the arm of the person who will be wearing it.

The appearance of a rash, redness, swelling or other signs of irritation could indicate an allergic reaction. Additionally, the American Academy of Ophthalmology warns that though wearing costume contact lenses on Halloween can be a real scream, the scare from non-prescription contact lenses can be all too real when chemical exposure or potentially blinding infections take place. As such, they should be avoided.

Pedestrian safety

Since trick-or-treating can take place when it's dark, Dr. Kang encourages parents to provide children with flashlights or glowsticks for lighting and greater visibility, which can be incorporated into the costumes.

Another option is sticking reflective arm bands or reflective tape to bags or costumes to ensure your child can be seen. It's recommended that parents review street safety ahead of time with their children.

COVID-19 safety

Last but not least, although COVID-19 may not be as much on the minds of parents this Halloween, Dr. Kang encourages children to wear a mask as part of their costume, when possible, especially if trick-or-treating indoors, to maximize protection.

Also, children should always wash their hands with soap upon returning from trick-or-treating. It's also important to only eat factory-wrapped treats and candy, as that is a safer practice.

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Hollywood actors want a deal

Studios are refusing to negotiate a new deal, putting people out of work.

Earlier this month, striking writers ratified a deal with major Hollywood studios that was greeted with excitement throughout the entertainment community. In a year of multiple strikes, it represented a major win for workers fighting growing income inequality.

Now, it's the actors' turn to reach a deal with studios — except that the studios have suspended talks with SAG-AFTRA, the union representing us.

The Alliance of Motion Picture and Television Producers (AMPTP) walked away from the bargaining table on October 11 and studio executives said they were suspending discussions because they were “no longer moving” forward “in a productive direction.” In short, the actors and studios remain in a stalemate.

In case you haven't followed the actors' strike, the AMPTP and SAG-AFTRA are negotiating revenue sharing and policies around use of artificial intelligence (AI), among other items. Until we get a deal, actors like me remain on the picket lines. And as long as we're on the picket lines, a lot of great shows won't be filmed, and a lot of folks who rely on this industry will be out of work.

Maybe you're thinking “wait, I thought actors make tons of money?” Well, sure, it can be millions and millions of dollars — if you're an A-lister. Most of us don't come anywhere close.

In my case, you may not know my name, but you might recognize my kind-of-familiar face from one of the shows I've appeared in. Some have been pretty big hits over the last five years, including the supernatural drama series “Manifest,” the psychological thriller series “You,” and “Modern Love,” an anthology series about human connection.

I'm fortunate to have enough success acting full time that I've been able to pay my bills and acquire health insurance. Back when my bookings were really booming, I proposed to my now wife and added a dog to our family — the typical sorts of things people do when they have financial stability.

But it's never been easy for the average actor to afford the conventional trappings of middle-class life — and it's getting harder all the time. One big problem for actors is that the business model for Hollywood film productions has completely changed, but the contracts have not. That's why actors went out on strike in July, a couple of months after the writers did.

Suffice to say, my not working for the past few months has been a financial hardship on my family. But the roughly 160,000 actors on strike are enduring what we hope to be a short-term pain for long term gains in pay, benefits and job protection. We miss the profession that we love, but we can't continue to work in conditions that compensate us less than our due and in an industry that fails to safeguard our careers as it embraces AI in a way that potentially could threaten our livelihoods.

A lot of Hollywood's biggest stars are on the picket lines too, lending us their moral support, for which I'm

grateful. They are fighting with us for fair wages in an industry where the average salary in 2022 was a paltry \$27.73 per hour for actors in California, according to the US Bureau of Labor Statistics. But most actors don't work a 40-hour work week, 12 months a year, so those stats may not fully capture just how precarious our livelihood is.

Acting is a notoriously tough profession to break into and maintain long-term security. Most of us who could were likely able to make a living did so because we were paid a fair wage based on viewership.

Prior to the advent of streaming, actors like me relied on residuals paid out based on how often we appeared in a show and how successful it was. That meant essentially, the more views, the more money we earned.

But the contracts we are operating under do not consider the dramatic increase in streaming numbers and the decline of network and cable viewership. In short, actors work much more to make ends meet and still sometimes find ourselves earning less.

When streaming first showed up, it had a lot of work to do to draw and maintain audiences. At the time, most of us were working in cable and network TV, which is where the audiences were. That large viewership, and the usage residuals this model provided, is why a lot of us were able to make a living. But the business has completely changed.

Last year, streaming in the US surpassed cable and network TV in viewership. Many actors depend on residuals from previous programs but in the streaming era, that income has fallen precipitously.

This immense shift has changed the model, and the AMPTP, which represents movie and television producers, including Disney, Warner Brothers and Netflix (CNN's parent company is Warner Bros. Discovery, which produces movies and television shows.) And even as studios say that they're being squeezed financially, CEOs continue to earn tens of millions of dollars.

Meanwhile, SAG-AFTRA says 86% of its members don't qualify for health care coverage through the union, because they don't qualify under SAG-AFTRA's income threshold, which is about \$26,500 a year.

What's more, many of us live in the most expensive cities in the country like Los Angeles and New York, because that's where the work and industry infrastructure exists. The average one-bedroom apartment in Los Angeles rents for about \$3,000 per month, according to rent.com, which comes to \$36,000 per year. So, if you're a Hollywood actor barely scraping by — well, you can do the math.

Another major sticking point is how the industry would like to use AI. The AI proposal from the AMPTP impacts the most marginalized and financially vulnerable performers in the entertainment industry — background actors.

Obviously, the way in which actors' images will be used is a hugely important issue. SAG-AFTRA negotiators say the proposed contract would pay background actors for a day's work (they currently are paid at the rate of less than \$200 per day), scan their body and use that image any way they want for the rest of the project. The union has also said that the studios want to own that scan to use for perpetuity, without the consent of the background actor and without providing further compensation. The AMPTP rejected this claim, and has said that they will require consent from the actor and the replica would only be used in the movie they signed up for.

output from the Trump pro-drilling trend. At least \$40 billion of that has gone to the Iranians. You can buy a lot of rockets with that kind of money.

Meanwhile, the Russian war machine is almost entirely funded with petrodollars. They love that the heart of the Biden climate policy is to produce 3 million barrels a day less than we could and should be.

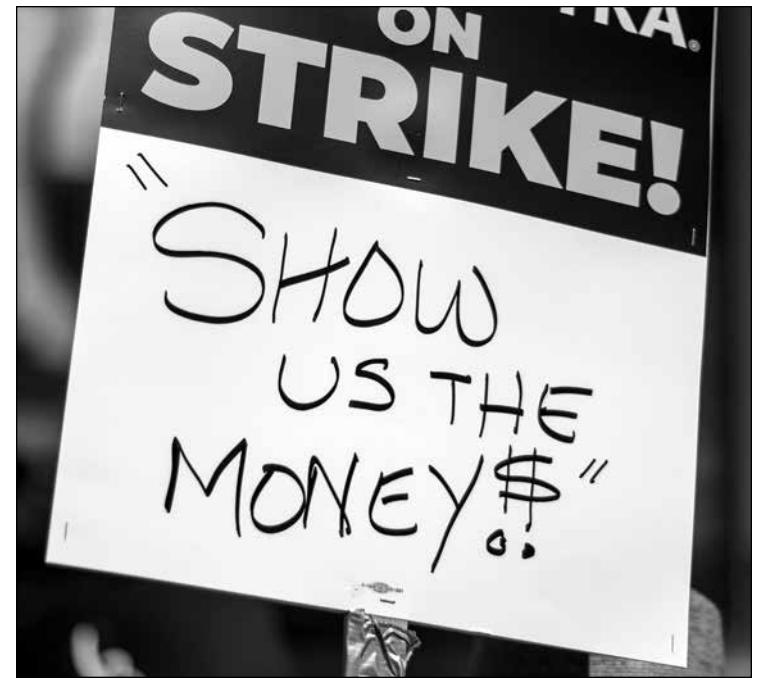
Biden misses a larger point about our national security. Right now, our debt is the nation's most urgent, clear and present danger — not just to our economic prosperity but to our national security. Presidents Ronald Reagan and Donald Trump believed rightly that when America is strong at home with an economy firing on all cylinders, we are strong, respected and feared abroad.

It's painful to say, but right now, America is far weaker militarily and economically than we were four years ago. The most important geopolitical power today is economic and technological superiority.

You don't achieve and retain that status by becoming the world's premier debtor nation.

Americans are starting to feel in the pocketbook the corrosive effect of a hemorrhaging \$6 trillion budget. Everything we buy is 17% more expensive as the government effectively prints and borrows money to pay its bills. Mortgage rates are surging, with a 30-year mortgage interest rate at 8%, up from 3% when since Trump left office.

This means that on an average-priced house with a 30-year mortgage, buyers will pay \$1,500 a month more in



But here's a sobering thought: AI technology is still incredibly young. We have no way of understanding or knowing what can be done with this information in 10, 20, or 30 years. The potential is limitless and protections for real people need to be put in place now.

You might be thinking, “With all your reservations about the way the business of Hollywood is run, why don't you just get a different job?” I'd turn the question around and ask you, “Wouldn't you fight for the job you love?”

Acting is my job. It's more than that — it's my passion. I've done thousands of auditions, performed thousands of hours on stage to hone my craft, finished hundreds of hours of really mediocre improv classes (and some good ones too) and made a cross-country move away from everyone and everything I know to pursue this career.

I think a lot of people were reminded of the value of on-screen entertainment in their lives during the Covid-19 pandemic. The stories we watched on big and small screens gave us something else to talk about — a way to escape the scary reality just outside our front door.

Several Hollywood A-listers, including Ben Affleck, Emma Stone and George Clooney, met with SAG-AFTRA leaders this week after the studios suspended negotiations. They've made overtures to try to end the strike, according to news reports; I'm hoping that all that star power helps get the talks back on track. The idea that underpaid union workers should “get a different job” while industry executives earn tens of millions of dollars feels like a post-apocalyptic show written by AI. But here we are — in real life.

Let's be clear: this fight is about the entire ecosystem that makes your favorite onscreen entertainment run. This includes actors like me, but also casting directors, costume departments, lighting crews, camera operators, producers, teamsters, make-up artists and so many more professionals with real lives, real families and real professional goals. None of us non-executives get rich working in this industry.

I couldn't be happier for my extended family in the Writers Guild of America whose sacrifice and determination allowed them to strike a deal with the studio execs that their leaders are happy with. Until the actors can say the same, you won't find my kind-of-familiar face on screen, but on the picket line.

payments. This will put homeownership out of reach for millions of Americans.

Then, there is the impact of skyrocketing federal interest payments on the debt. This year, for the first time, federal interest expenses exceed our entire national defense budget. With lower interest rate debt now turning over every day and having to be refinanced by issuing 5% and 6% Treasury bills, we're facing a death spiral of red ink.

Borrowing more money now would make all these problems much worse and make America less of a superpower going forward. Republicans should be insisting on three conditions for any more debt spending packages.

First, it has to be much smaller — cut at least by half — than \$100 billion. This isn't Monopoly money we are talking about.

Second, any release of new funds must be accompanied by a pro-drilling strategy here at home to divert money away from our enemies.

And third, every penny must be paid for dollar-for-dollar with other spending cuts. This isn't a heavy lift. We simply slash the \$380 billion green energy slush fund and other wasteful programs.

If Biden and Congress don't believe they can find and eliminate tens of billions of dollars of waste in the federal budget (about 1% of total spending), this is prima facie evidence that we need a new president and a new Congress.

IF YOU ARE A CREDITOR or a contingent creditor of the decedent, you must file your claim with the court and mail a copy to the personal representative appointed by the court within the later of either (1) four months from the date of first issuance of letters to a general personal representative, as defined in section 58(b) of the California Probate Code, or (2) 60 days from the date of mailing or personal delivery to you of a notice under section 9052 of the California Probate Code. Other California Statutes and legal authority may affect your rights as a creditor. You may want to consult with an attorney knowledgeable in California Law.

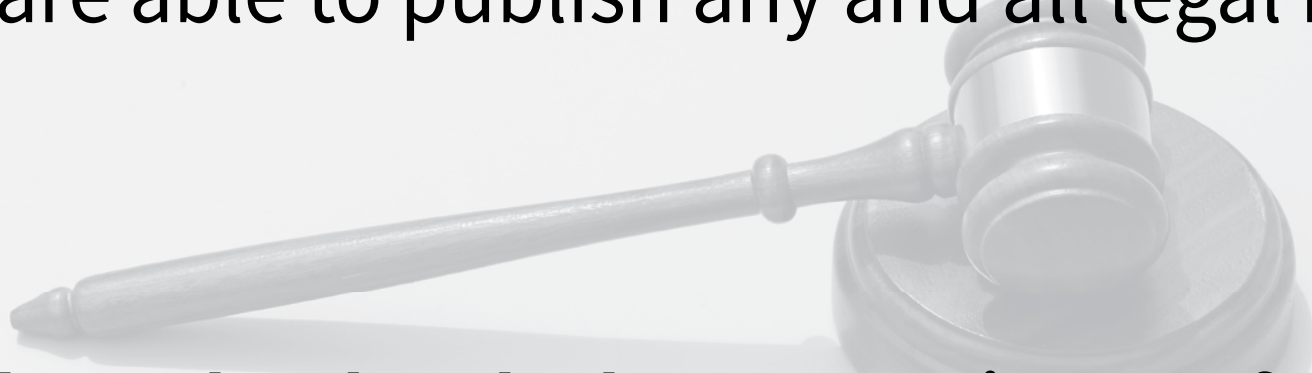
YOU MAY EXAMINE the file kept by the court. If you are a person interested in the estate, you may file with the court a Request for Special Notice (form DE-154) of the filing of an inventory and appraisal of estate assets or of any petition or account as provided in Probate Code section 1250. Cal High students learn leadership skills at great heights

■ Students participated in a high-ropes challenge where they overcame their fears.

WHITTIER — California High School's Academic Mentors embarked on a thrilling adventure at the Orange County Ropes Course, where they were pushed out of their comfort zones and taught valuable lessons in teamwork, courage and risk-taking.

The Orange County Ropes Course is an elaborate network of above-ground obstacles, climbing structures and a final zipline that are each designed to test a person's physical and mental abilities. The California High Academic Mentors faced the rope course on Oct. 5, building a strong mentality of overcoming obstacles that they will now bring to their mentoring sessions in the classroom.

As the Academic Mentors navigated the ropes course, they discovered the importance of effective communication and encouragement. Whether it was crossing a wobbly bridge or making the exhilarating descent down the zipline, they were taught that success often relied on their ability to support and uplift one another.

"Our Academic Mentors play an integral leadership role in the school," Principal Bill Schloss said. "They dedicate much of their time to helping all students achieve academic and personal success, as well as helping support them socially and emotionally."

The Academic Mentors also gained a deeper understanding of the importance of patience and looking just one step ahead at a time, as well as the benefit of pushing past comfort zones and developing a growth mindset.

"In the classroom, our mentors are often tasked with approaching reluctant

learners, and it can be difficult to get started engaging as a role model," California High School Intervention Specialist and math teacher Melissa Esquerra said. "Our goal in coordinating this field trip was to help our Academic Mentors gain more confidence and realize the potential of positive words in their work."

The California High School Academic Mentors are a group of juniors and seniors who help support teachers by working in small groups or one-on-one with mentees in classes that are designed to provide extra support to at-risk students.

Restaurant's expansion draws opposition

■ Tempo Cantina in Downey is seeking a larger outdoor patio but neighbors are opposed.

DOWNEY — A proposal by a popular Downey bar and restaurant to expand its outdoor seating area is receiving pushback from

neighboring residents.

Tempo Cantina, located at 12056 Paramount Blvd., filed for a conditional use permit that would allow it to more than double its outdoor dining area.

The restaurant has 3,405 sq. ft. of indoor space and it opened a 944 sq. ft. outdoor patio in 2020. The proposed permit would give Tempo Cantina an additional 1,000 sq. ft. of outdoor dining with

alcohol service.

Residents and property managers living near the restaurant, however, said they already suffer from excessive noise and trash, and increasing the bar's capacity would make matters worse.

Victoria Fujimoto is a property manager for the Villas at Downey, an apartment complex adjacent to Tempo Cantina. She said she has lost tenants due to excessive noise levels.

"As you can imagine this is disruptive to the quiet and enjoyment of our residents," Fujimoto said. "The residents are looking at us for answers and our hands are tied, we cannot seem to get the help we need. We've had more unit turnover in the building than ever before due to the noise, lack of street parking, debris and pest issues."

Ron Kolar, owner of L'Abri Management, said the city has done little to nothing despite more than two years of

complaints.

"We first brought this issue to the city via phone calls and messages to the city code enforcer back in January 2021," Kolar said. "We didn't see any improvements and we then wrote a letter back on July 15, 2021 addressed to city councilmember Sean Ashton and copied to code enforcement. In this letter we addressed the ongoing noise level, loud gatherings in the patio, debris and traffic congestion. We addressed the fact that we had

lost two residents due to the noise level coming from the establishment."

Kolar said "numerous residents" also called or wrote letters to the city complaining about the noise levels.

"Zero response from the city and no resolution to our problem," Kolar said.

According to a report prepared by the city's planning department for the Planning Commission, Downey Police were dispatched to Tempo Cantina 272 times between Oct. 20, 2018 and Oct. 12, 2023; of those calls, 81 were noise complaints.

As part of the permit application, city officials stipulated that the restaurant provide a noise study "with determinations for how to control noise generated by the new outdoor dining." Televisions and speakers would also be required to be equipped with noise monitoring devices that limit the equipment from surpassing a specific decibel sound.

Tempo Cantina is also requesting a permit to operate on-site valet parking. Of the property's 53 parking spaces, 37 would be designated for valet services.

The Planning Commission is expected to consider the permit applications at a later date.
