## NORWALK HIGH



March 14 was the 11th Annual Charity for Charities at Norwalk High School, an event where NHS students present donations to charities in front of a large crowd of students.

## Gas prices reach highest amount since November

■ Gas prices are climbing to their highest levels since last year; Costco remains the cheapest option.

**NORWALK** – The average price of a gallon of self-serve regular gasoline in Los Angeles County rose Wednesday to its highest amount since Nov. 28, increasing 1.1 cents to \$4.975, its fifth increase in six days.

The average price has risen 4.5 cents over the past six days, including seven-tenths of a cent Tuesday, according to figures from the AAA and Oil Price Information Service.

It rose three consecutive days, dropped one-tenth of a cent Monday and resumed

increasing Tuesday.

In Norwalk, the cheapest gasonline is at Costco, where a gallon of unleaded cost \$4.38 as of Thursday.

The average price is 4.4 cents more than one week ago, 16.6 cents higher than one month ago and 10 cents greater than one year ago. It has dropped \$1.519 since rising to a record \$6.494 on Oct. 5, 2022.

The Orange County average price rose to its highest amount since Nov. 20, increasing 2.1 cents to \$4.933, its fifth increase in six days. It has risen 5.4 cents over the past six days, including four-tenths of a cent Tuesday. The Orange County average price rose three consecutive days, dropped two-tenths of a cent Monday and resumed

increasing Tuesday.

The Orange County average price is 5.3 cents more than one week ago, 16.7 cents higher than one month ago and 10.9 cents greater than one year ago. It has dropped \$1.526 since rising to a record \$6.459 on Oct. 5, 2022.

The national average price rose for the eighth consecutive day, increasing 2.6 cents to \$3.515. It has risen 12.1 cents over the past eight days, including 2.2 cents Tuesday.

The national average price is 11.9 cents more than one week ago, 23.9 cents higher than one month ago and 7.2 cents greater than one year ago. It has dropped \$1.501 since rising to a record \$5.016 on June 14, 2022.

## Rio Hondo brings back invention camp

■ The two-week camp will teach adults how to turn their ideas into real products.

**WHITTIER** – Rio Hondo College will host its second annual Invention Camp Rio program for adults 18 years and older and high school students.

In partnership with Lemelson-MIT, Rio Hondo College faculty members in the disciplines of business, engineering and architecture will collaboratively lead the Invention Camp Rio.

Participants will learn the

invention process, prototyping, how to generate a business plan and a pitch for a product that can later become patented. A makerspace lab will be available to help design their product.

The program is free for any adult 18 years and older and high school students who are curious and eager to learn new things. It will be hosted from Monday, July 15 through Friday, July 26 from 9 a.m. to

Business Management Instructor, Eric Caesar, who led the summer program last year with LMIT educators and Rio Hondo College faculty, emphasized the importance of joining the program by highlighting the invaluable skill of developing creative solutions to problems.

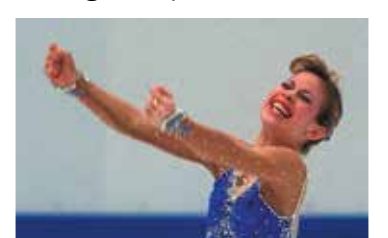

keeping this league going and Mario was a vocal champion to get us back to our home field once construction was completed," Vasquez said. # Feds promise greater focus on violent gun crime

■ Prosecutors will begin charging violent crime suspects with federal crimes, which carry harsher penalties.

LOS ANGELES – Law enforcement officials in Los Angeles are promising increased federal prosecutions of violent gun crime, but are denying Thursday the new Operation Safe Cities initiative was a response to what critics describe as a soft approach to prosecuting and sentencing by Los Angeles County District Attorney George Gascón.

Crimes involving commercial robberies, kidnappings, extortions and gun offenses are generally subject to stiffer penalties in federal court, where there is no parole, than in state court.

For example, commercial robbery offenses charged under the Hobbs Act -- dealing with robbery or extortion affecting interstate commerce -- each carry up to 20 years in federal prison, and these sentences can be significantly increased if the perpetrator used or simply possessed a firearm.

The Safe Cities initiative aims to strengthen existing partnerships between federal and local law enforcement to take the most violent and habitual offenders off the streets and expand the number of federal cases involving gun crimes, according to Martin Estrada, the U.S. Attorney in Los Angeles.

"We're hearing the community loud and clear," Estrada said Wednesday. "There are concerns about violent gun crime. People are fearful, and we're responding to that."

Among other things, the operation is designed to educate officers and detectives who typically deal with dangerous criminals about the process of presenting cases to federal prosecutors, Estrada

said at a news conference in downtown Los Angeles that included officials from the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department, the Los Angeles Police Department, the FBI and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives.

The effort to identify investigations and cases appropriate for federal prosecution is expected to increase the number of arrests, prosecutions and convictions of recidivists engaged in the most violent conduct, according to the U.S. Attorney's Office. The operation will target crimes involving illicit guns, prohibited persons possessing firearms, or robbery crews that cause havoc and extensive losses to retail establishments, Estrada said.

"We have limited enforcement resources, but we can multiply our efforts by collaborating with our colleagues at local police agencies to have the most significant impact on violent crime," he said.

Estrada told reporters he had spoken to Gascón and the district attorney was "supportive that we're targeting the worst of the worst." However, the county's top prosecutor was not present among the lineup of law enforcement officials Wednesday.

New LAPD Chief Dominic Choi said Wednesday that one of his goals is to strengthen the department's relationship with federal law enforcement and expand the number of LAPD staff with the knowledge to recognize which criminal cases could qualify for federal filing consideration.

"We're going out and training detectives in each area," Choi said. "This effort is to ensure the most violent people out there on the streets are prosecuted ... wherever they are committing crimes. Victims of crime deserve justice."

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# Politics are crushing our mental health

As people are bombarded with constant news, some are choosing to tune out.

Democracy is founded on the importance of having an informed citizenry, but what if we have reached the point where citizens find staying informed a challenge to their mental health? What I am hearing in my psychotherapy practice worries me deeply. The paradox of living in a 24-hour news cycle is that the quantity of news does not guarantee more knowledge. As we stare down the start of the 2024 presidential campaign, we must reconcile how to help people balance managing their capacity to function with their need to be informed.

The well-documented mental health crisis in our country can be attributed in part to the feelings of inevitability that we are facing the same two candidates as in the 2020 election and dysfunction in Congress will continue to reign. So now, rather than staying up to date with current events, my patients are withdrawing as much as possible from the news. Rather than compulsively listening to news, they are compulsively avoiding the news.

Even my most politically engaged patients are increasingly turning away from political news – but significantly, they are doing so on purpose. Withdrawing from political information or solicitations is an active stance as contrasted with the more common idea of disengagement or apathy, which is a passive stance. Their sense of purpose comes from maintaining an active stance of withdrawal as a silent protest against a system that feels broken and unfair.

Having a sense of agency is better for mental health than acquiescence, but it can be tricky to find the line between being informed versus overwhelmed. It's not that my patients don't care about the outcome of the election; far from it. But in their attempts to manage how much they are impacted by the campaigns, they are consciously restricting the amount of attention they will pay to the candidates.

Withdrawal is also a healthy response to fatigue. "Why do the ads have to start so early? They think if they blast me

enough it will change my mind? Honestly, if the election was today rather than in November, do people think the results would be different? Who hasn't made up their mind?" asked one patient incredulously. Because this election seems to be less about policy and more about personalities, there doesn't seem to be as much to learn. And the candidates have been sufficiently vetted for most people. In this milieu, more information can further the divide and confirm one's viewpoint rather than change opinion.

A patient recently expressed her need to limit news intake as a way to maintain her mental health: "I let them suck me in the last two elections, and look where it got me – nervous, not sleeping, a wreck," she said of her cable news consumption. "I won't be fooled again." Indeed, my patients talk openly about feeling skeptical of all news and being fed up with feeling lied to. While they tend to cluster toward one end of the political spectrum, this jaundiced viewpoint on the value of mainstream journalism cuts across political parties. More information is considered unwelcome rather than informative. As one patient said, "Democracy is already broken. We are living in a plutocracy now. I will vote out of habit, not because I think it matters."

My college-aged patients, however, have not yet developed voting habits and profess no desire to politically engage to the point of being unmotivated to vote. A December poll reflected just how low this enthusiasm is, with just 49% of individuals 18 to 29 years old "definitely" planning on voting in the presidential election. They experience politics as something happening around them or to them, but not about them. Unlike the enthusiasm expressed by students during the first election cycle of former President Barack Obama, the young adults in my practice now are more focused on making up for the time they lost during the pandemic. Their sense of powerlessness to get anyone in politics to care about what is foremost on their minds lends itself to withdrawing from larger national debates. "They are both older than my grandparents! I just can't get excited about voting," one college student in my practice said of President Joe Biden and former President Donald Trump. "If they understood us, they would figure out how we could vote by text." This is not a flip comment from an entitled young adult, but rather the sentiment of a citizen who feels forgotten.

In these expressions of withdrawal that I hear from my patients, there is an underlying depression. Taken together, a sense of powerlessness, skepticism and fatigue make a potent cocktail for despair. My patients are hardly alone: a September Pew Research Center survey, conducted

long before the first presidential primary, found 65% of respondents felt "exhausted" always or often when thinking about politics. Thus the remedy, withdrawal, can be understood as an active protective stance, one that attempts to allow the individual to go about life and function rather than giving in to hopelessness. In other words, by limiting their intake of news they are hoping to be less depressed.

Understanding this response from a psychological perspective is imperative if we want to build an active citizenry. Consider the example of adolescents who respond to requests from their parents by withdrawing to their room. As the parents yell louder, the teens go deeper into themselves, turning up their music and frustrating the parents further. Scare tactics only go so far when trying to change someone else's behavior. Without meaningful communication between the two sides, viewpoints become intractable.

The current practice of endless text messages from politicians running for office is a perfect illustration of such impotent scare tactics. My patients receive requests for money from candidates across the country; they consider these intrusive and they tune them out. When messages like these arrive during a session, patients express outrage that their perceived personal space is being violated: "My phone is on in case my husband or kids need me, not so someone I've never heard of can ask for money," one patient said. Actively texting STOP to these messages is one way of exercising power in a seemingly powerless situation.

However, developing a sense of purpose is a more effective antidote to despair than active withdrawal. Consequently, I encourage patients to identify ways they can actively participate in the election process rather than feeling victimized by it. For some, this has meant getting involved in local politics, where they have a greater connection to the candidates. For others, making the time to write postcards or call people in other states has enlivened their sense of being an American because they feel like they are doing something on their own terms rather than being apathetic.

The ultimate question is whether or not the choice to actively disengage from the campaigns will translate into lower voter turnout. The challenge is to support people's efforts to take care of themselves psychologically leading up to election day, while still engaging enough in the necessary steps to be able to vote. This will give them the benefit of knowing they participated even if they are unhappy with the outcome. As a country, and a people, we thrive when we have a sense of purpose.

# The case for a 32-hour work week

Despite massive improvements in productivity, Americans are still working longer than necessary.

Although it is rarely discussed in the media, the Senate overwhelmingly passed legislation to establish a 30-hour workweek in 1933. While that legislation ultimately failed because of intense opposition from corporate America, a few years later President Franklin D. Roosevelt signed the Fair Labor Standards Act into law and a 40-hour workweek was established in 1940.

Unbelievably, 84 years later, despite massive growth in technology and worker productivity, nothing has changed.

Today, American workers are more than 400 percent more productive than they were in the 1940s. And yet, despite this fact, millions of our people are working longer hours for lower wages. In fact, 28.5 million Americans now work over 60 hours a week and more than half of full-time employees work more than 40 hours a week.

The sad reality is, Americans work more hours than the people of most other wealthy nations. In 2022, U.S. workers logged 204 more hours a year than employees in Japan; 279 more hours than those in the United Kingdom; and 470 more hours than those in Germany.

Despite these long hours, the average worker in America makes almost \$50 a week less than he or she did 50 years ago, after adjusting for inflation.

Let that sink in for a moment. In a 1974 office, there were no computers, email, cellphones, conference calling or Zoom. In factories and warehouses, there were no robots or sophisticated machinery, no cloud computing. In grocery stores and shops of all kinds, there were no checkout counters using bar codes.

Think about all the incredible advancements in technology — computers, robotics, artificial intelligence — and the huge increase in worker productivity that has been achieved. What have been the results of these changes for working people? Almost all the economic gains have gone straight to the top, while wages for workers are stagnant or worse.

While CEOs are making nearly 400 times as much as their average employees, many workers are seeing their family lives fall apart, missing their children's birthday parties and Little League Baseball games, as they are forced to spend more time at work. What stresses them out even further is that many still do not have enough money to pay rent, put food on the table and send their kids to college without going deeply into debt.

This should not be happening in the United States of America in 2024. It's time for a 32-hour workweek with no loss in pay.

Let's be clear. This is not a radical idea: Belgium has already adopted a four-day workweek. Other developed countries are moving toward this model, such as France (35-hour workweek and considering reducing to 32) and Norway and Denmark (roughly 37-hour workweek). In 2019, Microsoft tested a four-day workweek in Japan and reported a 40 percent increase in productivity.

Last year, the United Kingdom conducted a four-day workweek pilot program of 3,000 workers at more than 60 companies, and it was a huge success for both workers and employers. Over 73 percent of workers who participated in this program reported greater satisfaction with their work.

Businesses that participated in this program saw a 35 percent average increase in revenue, and 91 percent of businesses opted to continue a four-day workweek after the study concluded.

Studies have shown that workers are either equally or more productive during a four-day workweek — one study found that worker productivity rose, with 55 percent saying their ability at work increased after companies adopted this new schedule. In addition, 57 percent of workers in companies that have moved to a four-day workweek have indicated that they are less likely to quit their jobs.

Moreover, at a time when so many of our people are struggling with their mental health, 71 percent of workers in companies that have moved to a four-day workweek report feeling less burnout, 39 percent reported feeling less stress and 46 percent reported feeling less fatigued.

Even Bill Gates, the founder of Microsoft, and Jamie Dimon, CEO of JPMorgan Chase, predicted last year that advancements in technology could lead to a three- or 3½-day workweek.

The question is: Who will benefit from this transformation? Will it be the billionaire class or workers? In our view, the choice is obvious. At a time of massive income and wealth inequality and huge increases in productivity, the financial gains from new technology must go to workers, not just to the people on top.

As part of their historic contract negotiations with the Big Three automakers — General Motors, Ford Motor Co. and Stellantis (formerly Chrysler) — the United Auto Workers called for the introduction of a four-day, 32-hour workweek at the same rate of pay and overtime pay for anything beyond that.

Despite significant gains for workers in their new contract, they were not successful in winning that demand. The struggle continues.

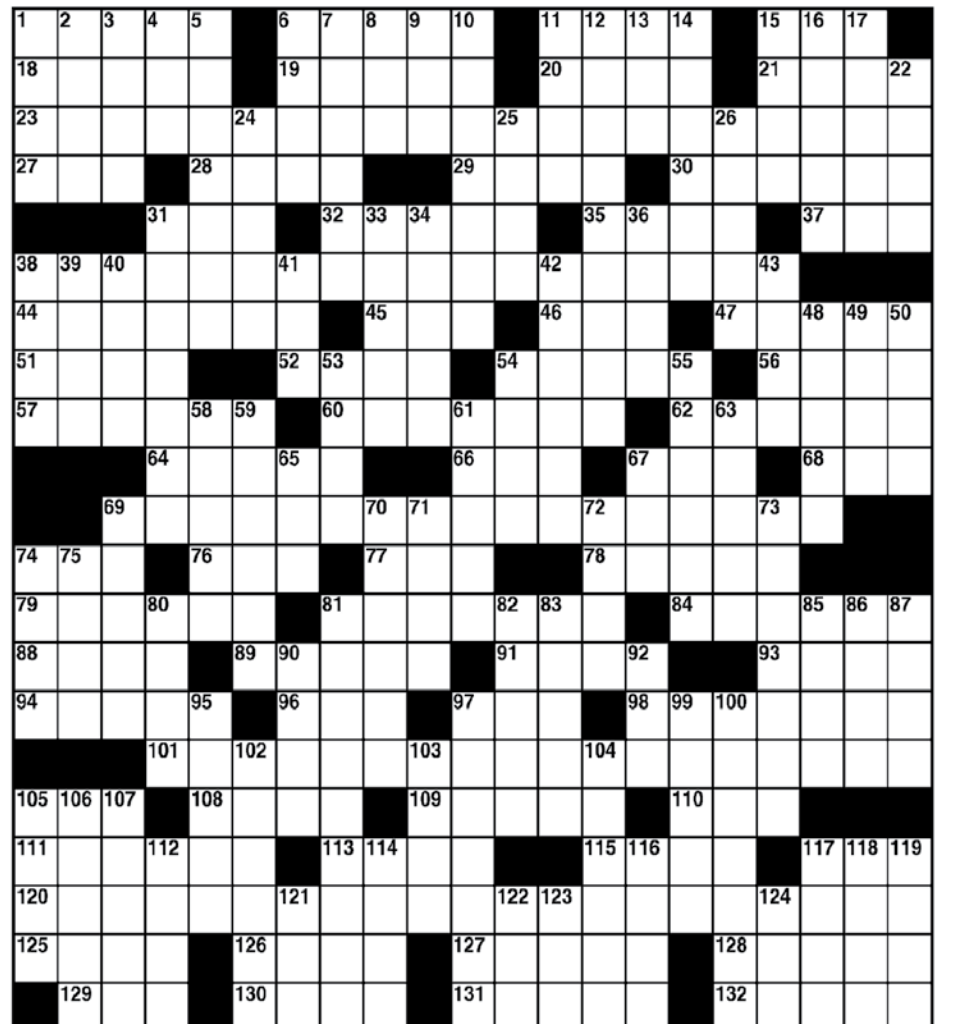

# OBITUARIES

## Joe Camp, creator and director of 'Benji' movies

Joe Camp, the creator, screenwriter, and director behind the beloved "Benji" movie franchise, died March 15 at his home in Bell Buckle, Tennessee, after a long illness at the age of 84.

"Benji" was Camp's first movie, first imagined while he was watching the animated classic "Lady and the Tramp" and wondering if a similar approach could work for a live-action dog movie. A dog lover, Camp saw his own dog's facial expressions and emotions and decided to make the first live-action movie from a dog's point of view, without a human narrating for the dog.

He wrote the script, fundraised, and shot the film, and when major studios didn't show any interest, he distributed it himself, releasing "Benji" in October 1974. The indie film became a smash hit – it was one of the year's top grossing movies, received critical acclaim, and became a beloved family classic.

Camp went on to make five more Benji feature films, most recently the 2018 Netflix reboot, "Benji," which he cowrote with his son, Brandon Camp.

## Paul Alexander, spent over 70 years in iron lung

Paul Alexander, who survived polio as a child and as a result was placed in an iron lung in 1952, in which he remained almost entirely confined for the rest of his life, died March 11 at age 78.

Alexander was just six years old when he contracted polio, leaving him paralyzed from the neck down. He was one of hundreds of children afflicted during a 1950s outbreak in the Dallas area, and among some 60,000 reported cases nationally in 1952 and 1953, before the polio vaccine gained widespread adoption. As a result, he was placed on an iron lung.

Through glossopharyngeal breathing techniques, he was able to leave the device for short periods of time, though he still had to sleep in it each night. Alexander devoted himself to his studies, learning to memorize rather than handwrite notes and graduating second from W.W. Samuell High School. He went to Southern Methodist University, then earned a doctorate in law from the University of Texas at Austin. He was admitted to the bar in 1986 and worked for years as an attorney, using a special wheelchair that held his body upright in court.

He also launched a TikTok in 2024 to share his story with others. Alexander was one of the last two people still using an iron lung – the other was Martha Lillard, who was placed inside one in 1953 and still survives.

## Sydell Miller, innovator of false eyelashes

Sydell Miller, the entrepreneur behind the successful and influential beauty brands Matrix and Ardell, co-founding them with her husband, the late Arnold Miller, died Feb. 25 at age 86.

Miller met her husband when she walked into his salon to have her hair done. He fell in love while he worked on her hair, and he proposed after just a few dates. Early in their marriage, she helped at the salon by answering phones, and her involvement there only grew. Soon, she was suggesting the first of her beauty innovations: a new process for applying false eyelashes.

The salon specialized in eyelashes, using a technique that was the industry standard at the time. Each lash was applied individually in a process that took hours and was expensive for the customer – yet lost money for the salon. A frustrated Miller took inspiration from a hair fall, in which individual hairs were hand-tied to a base. She applied the same concept to lashes and developed an innovative single-piece false lash style. The new product was a hit, and the couple created Ardell – combining their two first names – to market their new false eyelashes.

The company remains a leader in the industry, more than 50 years later, though the Millers sold the brand in the early 1980s.

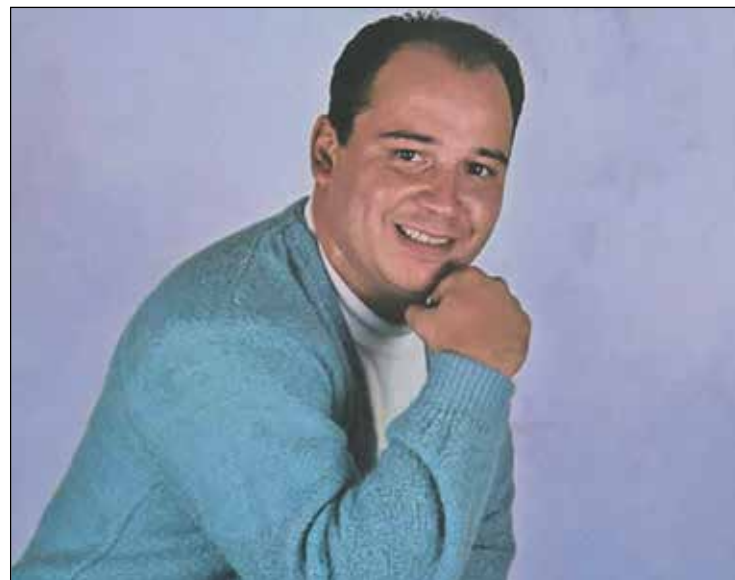
## Pete Rodriguez, 'I Like It Like That' bandleader

Pete Rodriguez, the bandleader and pianist for Pete Rodriguez y Su Conjunto, known for their 1967 boogaloo hit, "I Like it Like That," died March 11 at age 89.

Born in New York City, Rodriguez grew up steeped in Latin music, and his own work helped bring that music into the mainstream. After serving in the U.S. Marine Corps in the 1960s, he came home to form Pete Rodriguez y Su Conjunto (Pete Rodriguez and His Band). They played the emerging style of boogaloo, which merged Latin rhythms with American R&B and soul.

Rodriguez and his band turned out one of the best-known and most enduring hits of boogaloo when they recorded "I Like It Like That." Rodriguez's piano anchors the catchy, danceable tune, sung by trumpeter Tony Pabon. The song has been widely covered and heard in movies, TV shows, and video games, including "Chef" and "Grand Theft Auto: Vice City Stories." Its success was part of what led to Rodriguez being crowned "The King of Boogaloo."

Rodriguez and his band recorded more than a dozen albums, mostly in the 1960s but with a few coming in later years. Rodriguez performed sporadically after the band's early fame, and he said he appreciated the long-lasting popularity of his biggest hit.

## Richard Truly, former astronaut who led NASA

Richard Truly, an astronaut and vice admiral in the U.S. Navy who became the first former astronaut to lead the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA), died Feb. 27 of Parkinson's disease. He was 86.

Growing up in Fayette, Mississippi, Truly dreamed of being a pilot, but didn't think he could become one. That changed while he was earning his degree in aeronautical engineering from Georgia Institute of Technology. He joined the ROTC, entered the U.S. Navy, and in 1960 went to flight school. Soon he was flying F-8 Crusaders and taking off from aircraft carriers.

In 1965, he began training for orbital work and was officially pulled into NASA in 1969. Truly was part of all three Skylab missions in 1973 and the Apollo-Soyuz mission in 1975. In 1981, he piloted the Space Shuttle Columbia and made history, as it was the first time a spacecraft had ever been reflown into space. He also piloted the Challenger during a 1983 mission.

After the Challenger disaster of January 1986, Truly stepped up to become NASA's Associate Administrator for Space Flight, where he was tasked with rebuilding the space shuttle program. By 1988, when the Discovery took off for the first mission since the Challenger explosion, he had accomplished his mission. Truly then stepped up to become NASA's administrator, serving in the role from 1989 to 1992.

Truly left NASA in 1992, joining the Georgia Tech Research Institute as vice president and director, then serving as director of the Department of Energy's National Renewable Energy Laboratory.

Truly is in the Georgia Aviation Hall of Fame and among many other honors received the Society of Experimental Test Pilots James H. Doolittle Award and the Johnson Space Center Superior Achievement Award.

## Grant Page, stunt performer on 'Mad Max'

Grant Page, a daring stunt performer from such Australian films as "Mad Max," "Mad Max Beyond Thunderdome," and "The Man from Hong Kong," died March 14 in an auto accident. He was 85.

Page was a key figure in the so-called Ozploitation movement, an Australian-born genre of low budget, high-action films best known for the influential 1979 movie "Mad Max." Page attended the University of Adelaide and later trained with the Commandos special forces unit in Australia, acquiring skills he'd eventually put to work on the big screen.

Beginning with 1975's "The Man from Hong Kong" and "The Love Epidemic," Page made a name for himself as a reliable and daring stuntman and stunt coordinator in the Australian film industry. His work in 1979's "Mad Max," in which he barreled a car through a full-loaded caravan, helped make the movie a cult classic and spawned a successful film franchise. He also worked with director George Miller in 1985's "Mad Max Beyond Thunderdome."

Other works include the cult favorite "Stunt Rock," a mockumentary starring Page, the thriller "Road Games," and "Mad Dog Morgan," in which he leaps off an 80-foot cliff while doubling for Dennis Hopper. Even after he stopped doing major stunts himself, Page continued to work as a stunt coordinator right up until 2020's "The Legend of Five."

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
