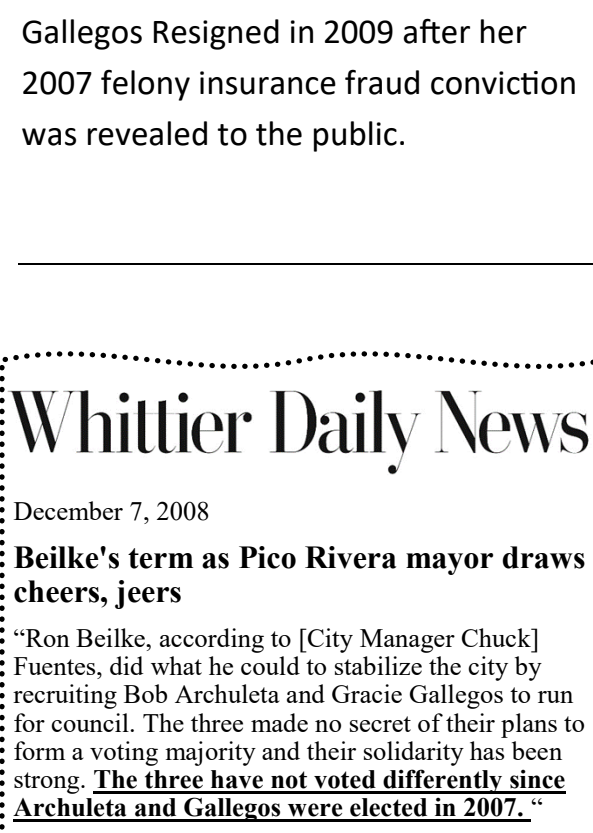

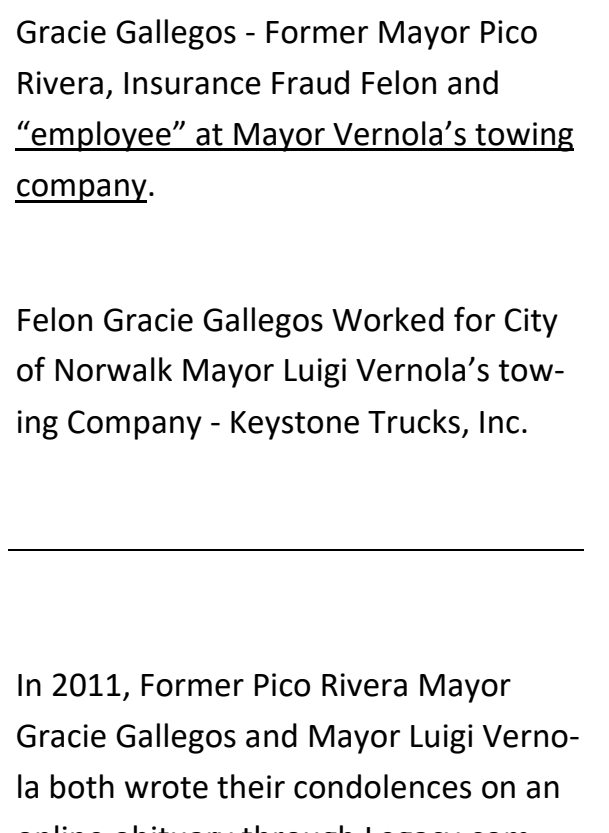


Former Pico Rivera Mayor Gracie Gallegos (insurance fraud felon and "friend" of NASA) and Mayor Bob Archuleta

Mayor Bob Archuleta - Dismisses HF&H Report saying NASA is not qualified and then directs waste contract to NASA.

Archuleta was a political ally of former Pico Rivera mayor Gracie Gallegos – Gallegos Resigned in 2009 after her 2007 felony insurance fraud conviction was revealed to the public.

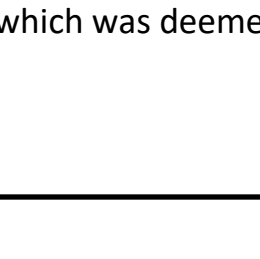
"A former Pico Rivera mayor was sentenced Wednesday to three years probation and 30 days community service and was also banned from running for public office for four years."

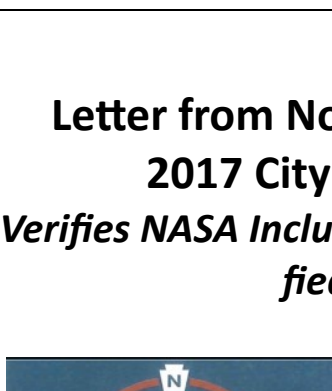

NASA Services Submitted a Bid for a Waste Hauling Contract with the City of Norwalk in 2016, but Was Not Chosen to Advance in the Bidding Process Due to Having Higher Costs than Other Service Providers

According to a staff report submitted to the Norwalk City Council on January 11, 2017, NASA Services submitted a proposal to the city by February 2016. The staff report stated that **HF&H Consultants (the same consultants used by the City of Pico Rivera in 2012 for their waste hauling contract process) had been hired to review the 11 proposals received by the city for the Integrated Solid Waste Management Services contract.**

In its review, HF&H Consultants stated that **5 out of the 11 companies** that had submitted proposals were **chosen to advance** in the bidding process. NASA Services was not among these 5 companies.

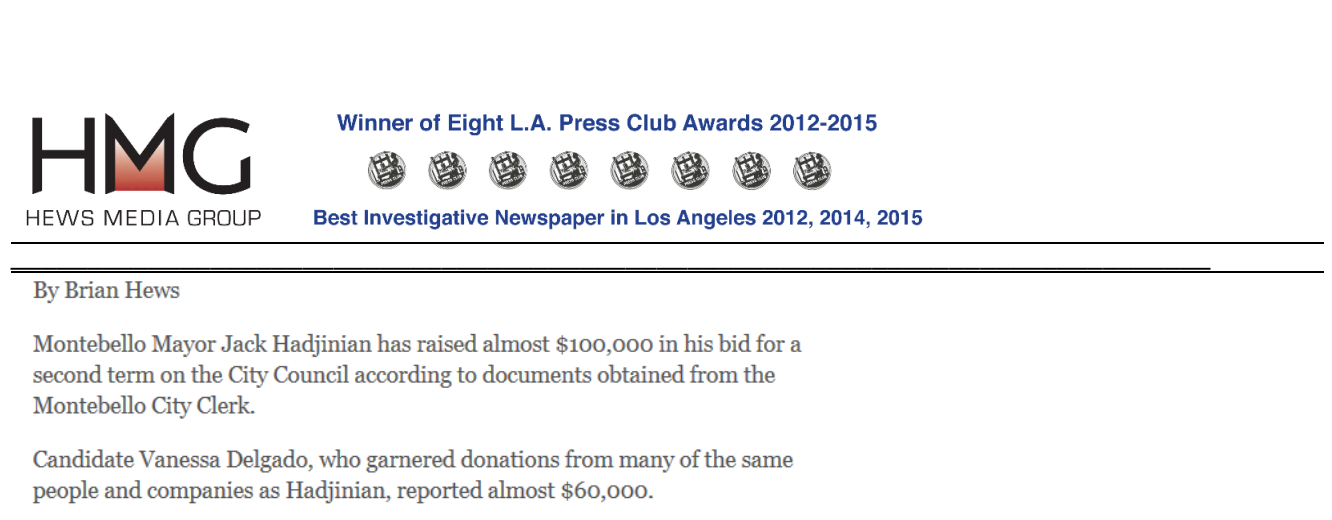
HF&H stated that the proposals from the other 6 bidders – including **NASA Services – had not been chosen because the companies' proposed costs were higher than the costs proposed by the incumbent service providers...** which did not warrant a change in provider.

HF&H's review showed that **NASA Services' proposal** would have only resulted in **a 1% savings for the** City of Norwalk as shown below.

HF&H's review of the bids showed that an exclusive contract with the **City of Norwalk would represent 40% of NASA Services' total revenue**, which was deemed **to be too high of a risk for the City.**

On May 6, 2017 the City interviewed eight proposers a Special City Council meeting. At the end of that meeting the City Council selected the following five companies to move forward in the selection process (in alphabetical order):

- Republic

The Mayor appointed an Ad-Hoc Committee to meet with aforementioned proposers to further evaluate their proposals, negotiate terms and bring back a recommendation to the City Council for consideration

Notably, as indicated by two red arrows in the screenshot below, Arsen Sarkisian (in dark sunglasses) and Nick Sarkisian (in a NASA Services hat) were with Beltran golfing. Pico Rivera Councilmember David Armenta was also with Beltran and the Sarkisians.

Montebello Mayor Jack Hadjiniian has raised almost \$100,000 in his bid for a second term on the City Council according to documents obtained from the Montebello City Clerk.

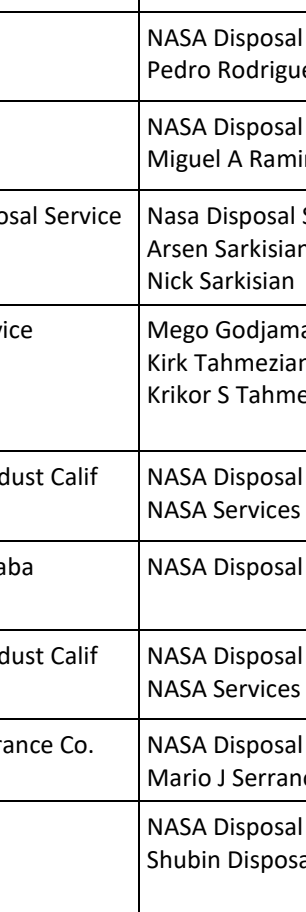
Candidate Vanessa Delgado, who garnered donations from many of the same people and companies as Hadjiniian, reported almost \$60,000.

Last week, HMG-CN connected Hadjiniian to a political action committee called Protect Local Jobs ("PLJ").

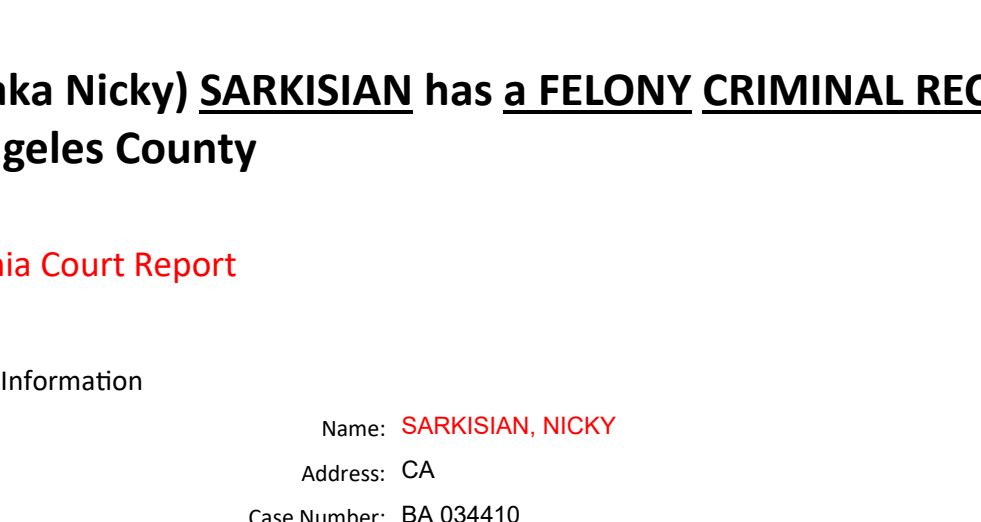
Some of the most corrupt politicians and political operatives are associated with PLJ including indicted former State Senator Ron Calderon, and his brother indicted former Assemblyman Tom Calderon.

The list also includes former Bell Gardens City Councilman Mario Beltran, convicted of using Ron Calderon's campaign money for a legal defense fund.

HMG-CN also learned that Beltran, who works for Nasa Disposal Services, is secretly running Hadjiniian's campaign.



A Facebook page (Sanitation Workers Uniting) created by Teamsters Local 396 to promote efforts to unionize sanitation workers includes a post from June 2016 that claims Beltran works for NASA Services. The Facebook post accuses Beltran of "getting paid by NASA Services to find ways to cheat workers at NASA out of a living wage and out of the dignity and respect that they deserve."

Councilman Mario Beltran pleads guilty to embezzlement

A Bell Gardens Councilman accused of embezzling campaign funds pleaded guilty today to multiple counts, prosecutors announced.

Mario Beltran, 31, pleaded to four misdemeanor counts, including failing to file campaign disclosure forms and failing to deposit cash contributions, all violations of the Political Reform Act, Deputy Dist. Atty. Max Hunstman said in a press release.

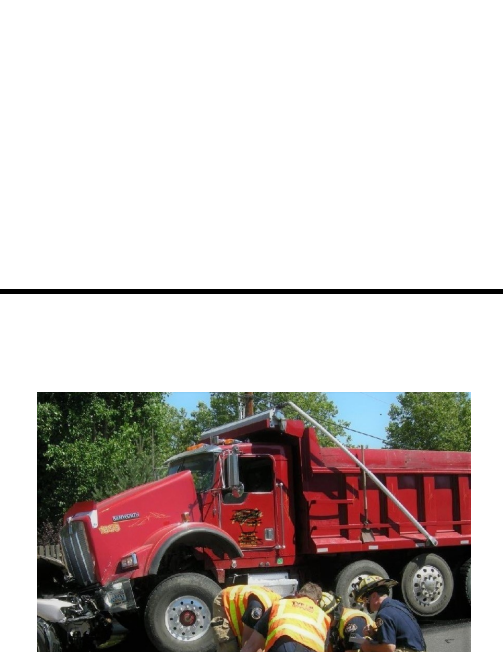
The charges stem from the defendant's failure to report to authorities how he was spending campaign funds entrusted to him and his failure to deposit and account for cash given to him, according to the press release.

Los Angeles Superior Court Judge George G. Lomeli ordered Beltran back for sentencing on Feb. 12. The defendant must resign from office before sentencing. Beltran is expected to receive four years of probation during which time he may not hold elected or appointed office and may not seek elected office or lobby.

Seven counts of grand theft, one count of perjury and one count of failing to deposit cash will be dismissed at sentencing as part of a negotiated plea agreement. In a previous prosecution in 2007, the defendant was convicted by a Downey jury of a misdemeanor charge of filing a false police report.

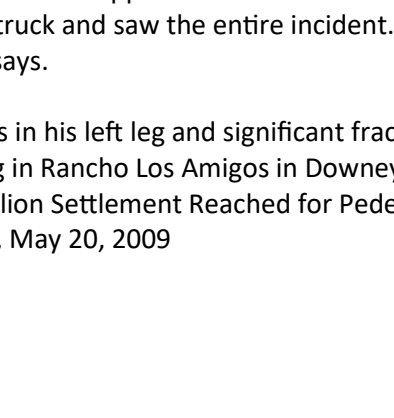

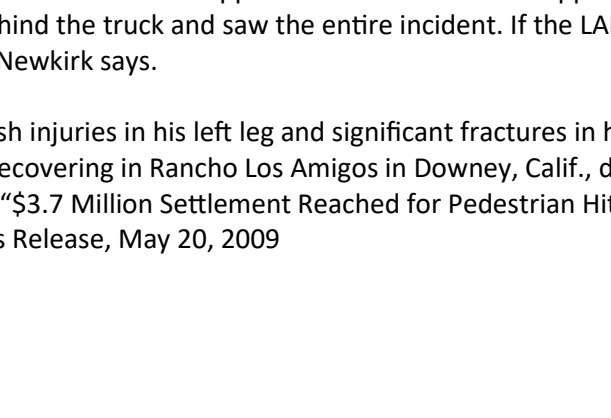

In 2009, NASA Services Agreed to a \$3.7 Million Settlement with a Pedestrian Hit by One of its Trash Hauling Trucks and Dragged 25 Yards

In 2009, NASA Services agreed to a \$3.7 million settlement with a pedestrian, Gerald Hatten, who sued the company after one of its trash hauling trucks hit him and dragged him 20-25 yards.

According to Hatten's attorney, the NASA Services driver "never saw Hatten..." and that the "only reason the truck stopped was because it was stopped by a Los Angeles Police Department squad that was behind the truck and saw the entire incident. If the LAPD hadn't been there, Gerald would probably have died."

A \$3.7 million settlement was reached in Gerald Thomas Hatten vs. NASA Services, Inc., Martin Berry Richardson; et al (Case #: BC394676) filed in Los Angeles Superior Court in July 2008.

"I doubt that any amount of money can really compensate Gerald who probably will be confined to a wheelchair for the rest of his life," says Los Angeles plaintiff attorney Bill Newkirk of the Law Offices of William H. Newkirk. "But this settlement will ensure that Gerald can live as full a life as possible, considering his injuries, and that he can access the medical treatment and rehabilitation that he will need throughout his life."

Hatten, 59 years old, was in a crosswalk at a green light, walking across Main Street in downtown Los Angeles at 6:50 in the morning on Feb. 13, 2008.

A 1995 Pterbilt tractor-mounted trash hauling truck belonging to NASA Services, Inc. of Montebello came around the corner to make a right turn onto Main Street. The truck hit Hatten and dragged him 20 - 25 yards down the street under the front of the truck.

"The driver apparently never saw Hatten," says Newkirk. "We think the driver was looking left while making a right turn. In fact, the only reason the truck stopped was because it was stopped by a Los Angeles Police Department squad that was behind the truck and saw the entire incident. If the LAPD hadn't been there, Gerald would probably have died," Newkirk says.

Hatten suffered vascular crush injuries in his left leg and significant fractures in his right leg. Eighteen months after the accident he is still recovering in Rancho Los Amigos in Downey, Calif., due to vascular compromises and infections in his left leg.
